The Shire of Yilgarn Council and Staff, in conjunction with the Tourism Advisory Committee is pleased to unveil the new logo for the Shire of Yilgarn, as seen on the Crosswords front cover.

The Tourism Advisory Committee, together with Market Creations Agency, developed a Tourism Marketing Strategy and Activation Plan, to seek to preserve, enhance and share the Shire of Yilgarn's culture, heritage, and natural and built environment.

The first phase of the strategy was brand development and awareness, with a modern logo identified as a key priority. The below image details the meaning behind the logo, there is also a great video put together by Market Creations Agency to show visually how the logo was developed. 

Year 4/5/6 Class



Díd you know?

Did you know it is almost a hundred years since farming took off in Yilgarn? The chief reason for the expansion was to repay returning soldiers from the Great War with land. Most were British. Despite the Agricultural Dept advising that Yilgarn was more suited to grazing than cropping, the government went ahead and moved the agricultural boundary from Walgoolan to Ghooli. Eleven hundred farms were created for eleven hundred families. A dozen schools were built. Farm size was a thousand acres as this was considered sufficient. Money was not needed as the Agricultural Bank was prepared to lend until settlers got on their feet, and the district flourished on the back of borrowed money. However the plan to make Southern Cross the centre of the Wheatbelt, failed. Farmers were just getting on their feet when they were hit by ten years of depression, followed by five years of war. The market price for wheat was less than the cost of production. Most new-land farmers walked off and surrendered their farms to the Agricultural Bank, with nothing to show for years of hard work. The worst hit areas were on the eastern fringe of the Wheatbelt: Bullfinch, Turkey Hill, Wheatley, Ghooli, and Miners Settlement. A reconstruction programme followed in the 1940's, with abandoned farms offered to those left on the land. Farm sizes increased to encourage broad acre farming. Unreliable rainfall was still a factor, and conditions had to be at their best for farmers to succeed. The industry then consolidated as neighbour bought out neighbour. The downside was losing farming families from the district, and the business and flow on effect this generated. What will the next 100 years bring! ©Lance Stevens


