



Local Government Reform Stronger local democracy


The State Government is introducing the most **significant reforms of local government** in 25 years.





Please be advised that the CRC will be closed on Friday 28th July 2023 due to a tree planting day with the local schools.



Stage 1.

Citizens who built this district between years 1887 and 1914

Forrester, Percy: Took up 160 acres in 1904 on the edge of town and commenced a dairy. Over the years he grew to become the largest landholder and first full-time farmer in the district. Undoubtedly the leading farmer in Yilgarn during his time, he also served some years as a member of Yilgarn Road Board. As a measure of his standing he was invited to sit on the Land Board to allocate new farms to returning soldiers after the First World War. He died in 1955 and is buried in the local cemetery.

Main Roads are continuing road works on Great Eastern Highway:

- Walgoolan Bridge Replacement construction is continuing and a side track is in place to limit the
 impact on traffic. The road is being widened for around 6 kilometres and in the summer months
 there will be lane closures with minor delays when the new and old roads are joined. Works are
 due for completion in December 2023.
- Bodallin 15 kilometres of Great Eastern Highway around Bodallin is being widened. Works also include a new two-kilometre eastbound passing lane between Bodallin and Moorine Rock, construction of a new westbound rest area between Bodallin and Moorine Rock and a realignment to the Bodallin townsite. Earthworks and culvert replacements are currently in progress in Bodallin. Around 8 kilometres of side tracks are in place and operational to limit the impact on traffic. In the summer months, earthworks and service relocations will be completed and the road sealed which will involve lane closures and minor delays. Works are due for completion in April 2024.
- Moorine Rock 1 kilometre of road around Moorine Rock Bridge will be widened and guardrail
 installed. Works will recommence around September and are due for completion in October 2023.
 Upgrades are also planned for Parker Range Road intersection. Works are due to commence in
 October 2023 and for completion by April 2024.
- Ghooli Upgrades to 11 kilometres of the Great Eastern Highway at Ghooli (10 kilometres east of Southern Cross) has been recently completed. There are plans to widen, reconstruct and seal a further 11 kilometres of road east of the new upgrades.






