Share what living in the Wheatbelt is like with doctors of the future

More than one hundred medical students will be coming to the Wheatbelt in March 2024. During their stay, they will visit local farms, industry, general practices, hospitals and schools, and participate in community activities.

We need you to provide real-life experiences that will give them an understanding of what it is like to live in the Wheatbelt and perhaps inspire them to become rural doctors.

The students will visit the following towns:

- Bruce Rock
- Cunderdin
- Kellerberrin/Tammin

- Southern Cross
- Westonia
- Merredin

As a host, we will ask you to provide accommodation for two or more students, be able to assist with transporting them to/ from town, and share what it is like to live in your town with the students. You are invited to come along to a Thank You Dinner with the students on the Thursday night.





Why host?

Even if you need the students to roll out a swag in the living room, we want to hear from you if you can host.

This is a life-changing experience for the students, with many having no previous exposure to rural life or the Wheatbelt.

By providing these rural immersion opportunities early in their degree, it has been proven that students are more likely to explore rural career opportunities.

Some students, who have previously been hosted through this program, continue to keep in touch and visit their host families, some return to do seasonal work and placements, others have joined mentoring programs, some have inspired host family members to pursue tertiary studies in health and medicine, and some students are now doctors in the Wheatbelt and other parts of rural/remote WA and Australia.

Water supply in a bushfire

This information could save your life

While leaving high-risk bushfires is the safest option, if you plan to stay and defend your home, you must have an INDEPENDENT water supply and pumping capability. This typically requires water tanks of at least 20,000 litres, pump and generator.

This is required as mains water supply and pressure cannot be guaranteed during a bushfire due to the risk of power cuts, fire damage and extreme demand.

Use the Department of Fire and Emergency Services resources to develop your personal bushfire plan: mybushfireplan.wa.gov.au. You can also download the My Bushfire Plan app via the App Store or Google Play to access your bushfire plan anytime - even without an internet connection.

To support bushfire plans, if you have groundwater bore access to surface water, you can take and store emergency water without it counting against your annual entitlement. For more information on this, and for the location of emergency bushfire water supplies in dryland agricultural areas, visit the Department of Water and Environmental Regulation website.

Drinking water

We recommend you keep a supply of drinking water on hand throughout summer in case your water supply is interrupted.

Assistance for customers affected by bushfire

After a bushfire, we can assist you with issues such as damaged water meters and payment difficulties. If you have been affected by bushfire please call us on **13 13 85**.

The Emergency WA website **emergency. wa.gov.au/** provides emergency information and community safety warnings. Call **000** in a life-threatening emergency or the SES **132 500** for emergency assistance.

EASTERN DISTRICTS COMBINED WINTER SPORTS COMMITTEE

The Eastern Districts Football League, Corrigin and Districts Netball Association, Eastern Districts Hockey Association and Roe Districts Hockey Association together with the Winter Sports Working Group have agreed to form a Combined Committee to:

- Liaise with local Winter sports clubs regarding meeting outcomes.

Clubs must notify the Winter Sports Project Officer of their unanimously nominated representative by FEBRUARY 19th 2024.



Pioneers of Pilgarn

Stage 1.

Citizens who built this district between years 1887 and 1914

Hatt, David: Came to Southern Cross during late 1890's to become a big player in the mining scene. A plumber by trade, he designed steel vats to treat old battery sands by cyanide. Cyanide released the left-over gold which could not be extracted by ordinary means. Hatt also owned Hatt's Reward gold mine on the edge of town. This operated by electricity, a new invention to Southern Cross. Hatt's battery was on top of Wimmera Hill where remains can still be seen today. When denied the use of free salt water from the lake to run his battery, Hatt moved lock stock and barrel to Never-Never (Nevoria) which had recently been discovered. A township developed with Hatt being unofficial Mayor and largest employer. His energy and vision was a boon for the south region. Hatt committed suicide in 1910 when he got into financial trouble, a sad ending for an entrepreneur of Yilgarn.

Hatton, Annie: Annie and her husband ran the Mount Jackson hotel for a number of years. When her husband died in 1906, Annie took over the hotel license and continued operating. This displayed the courage of the young woman, living in a male dominated mining settlement with the closest town being Southern Cross 100 miles away. The local paper lamented that a new workforce was needed at the mine as men had given way to the drink.


