More than one hundred medical students will be coming to the Wheatbelt in March 2024. During their stay, they will visit local farms, industry, general practices, hospitals and schools, and participate in community activities.

We need you to provide real-life experiences that will give them an understanding of what it is like to live in the Wheatbelt and perhaps inspire them to become rural doctors.

The students will visit the following towns:

- Bruce Rock
 - Cunderdin
- Kellerberrin/Tammin
- Narrogin
- Southern Cross
- Westonia
- Merredin

As a host, we will ask you to provide accommodation for two or more students, be able to assist with transporting them to/ from town, and share what it is like to live in your town with the students. You are invited to come along to a Thank You Dinner with the students on the Thursday night.



Why host?

Even if you need the students to roll out a swag in the living room, we want to hear from you if you can host.

This is a life-changing experience for the students, with many having no previous exposure to rural life or the Wheatbelt.

By providing these rural immersion opportunities early in their degree, it has been proven that students are more likely to explore rural career opportunities.

Some students, who have previously been hosted through this program, continue to keep in touch and visit their host families, some return to do seasonal work and placements, others have joined mentoring programs, some have inspired host family members to pursue tertiary studies in health and medicine, and some students are now doctors in the Wheatbelt and other parts of rural/remote WA and Australia.

Robin Stevens



Robin met local boy, Lance Stevens, and they got married in 1962. They moved around a lot in the early years of their marriage with Lance working for the Railway.

In 1984 they made the move back to Southern Cross to run the local News Agency, which they ran for 10 years. They left once again and returned in 2013 as a retired couple.

Her husband's well-known passion for local history rubbed off on Robin, whether it was welcomed or not, that may be up for debate!

Citizenship Awards

Robin is probably most well known in the community for working tirelessly at the Yilgarn History Museum, firstly, as a volunteer and then taking on the unenviable role of Curator when Carla Della Bosca left. She has only recently resigned from this role, at the end of 2022, leaving the Museum a modern and updated showcase of our region.

Robin masterminded a revamp of many of the Museum displays you can visit today. Some of the many tasks that Robin took on are:

- Procuring and setting up glass cases for better displaying of precious items,
- Creating a Modern Electronics cabinet,
- Creating a St John Ambulance display,
- Taking inspiration from various other museums Robin designed and oversaw the hanging of farming and mining tools on polished floor boards.
- Robin gave the aboriginal display a much-needed face lift. This is a very popular display where many family members look for names and faces of their relatives.
- Robin was instrumental in obtaining storage boxes for the precious historical items.
 These fragile items, such as aged clothing are now stored correctly ensuring their longevity for future displaying. Sorting and collating all the items was a very large undertaking and was completed with her attention to detail.
- Robin researched and organised the digitalisation of old Shire record books which are now on CDs for future researchers.
- The upgrade of the external area was instigated by Robin with a new toilet block installed as well as new paving. The yard is a pleasure to visit, neat, tidy and with room to install more displays if needed.
- The background on the Utility shed, painted by Teresa Wallace, was another project organised by Robin.

There are many examples of Robins eye for detail and thinking outside the box, and without her input and hard work, the Yilgarn History Museum would be just another run of the mill country museum.

Robin has been the primary mover and shaker in the last 9 years and, the Yilgarn History Museum would not have become one of the best museums in the Wheatbelt/Goldfields without her guidance and hard work. Robin had a gift of seeing what needed to be changed, the organizational skills to enlist help and the push to finish the job, whatever it took. Under her watch it has become a wonderful museum the community can be proud of.

Other things that Robin has been passionately involved in within the Yilgarn community include:


Volunteering for the Driver Reviver campaign, the Hospital Auxiliary, the Tourism Committee and representing the town in the Senior's Games.

Water supply in a bushfire

This information could save your life

While leaving high-risk bushfires is the safest option, if you plan to stay and defend your home, you must have an INDEPENDENT water supply and pumping capability. This typically requires water tanks of at least 20,000 litres, pump and generator.

This is required as mains water supply and pressure cannot be guaranteed during a bushfire due to the risk of power cuts, fire damage and extreme demand.

Use the Department of Fire and Emergency Services resources to develop your personal bushfire plan: mybushfireplan.wa.gov.au. You can also download the My Bushfire Plan app via the App Store or Google Play to access your bushfire plan anytime - even without an internet connection.

To support bushfire plans, if you have groundwater bore access to surface water, you can take and store emergency water without it counting against your annual entitlement. For more information on this, and for the location of emergency bushfire water supplies in dryland agricultural areas, visit the Department of Water and Environmental Regulation website.

Drinking water

We recommend you keep a supply of drinking water on hand throughout summer in case your water supply is interrupted.

Assistance for customers affected by bushfire

After a bushfire, we can assist you with issues such as damaged water meters and payment difficulties. If you have been affected by bushfire please call us on **13 13 85**.



Southern Cross General Practice is receiving an order of Monovalent Omicron XBB.1.5. Covid-19 vaccination

Appointments Available from Tuesday 14th February 2024. Please call us on 90491147 to book an appointment or to discuss eligibility.

All currently available COVID-19 vaccines are anticipated to provide benefit to eligible people, however the monovalent Omicron XBB.1.5 vaccines are preferred over other vaccines as it provides protection to the Omicron subvariants currently circulating in Australia.

***The below information is the 2023 ATAGI recommendations. They have advised people who become eligible for 2023 doses should continue to receive these doses until updated advice becomes available in early 2024. This is the most current and up to date advise. ATAGI notes the recent increase in COVID-19 cases across Australia since November 2023. ATAGI encourages all people who have not yet had their recommended 2023 dose/s to receive them as soon as possible 6 months or greater following the most recent COVID-19 vaccine dose or confirmed infection. ***

ATAGI continues to encourage all adults who were recommended to have a COVID-19 vaccine dose in February 2023, and who have not yet had one, to receive a vaccine dose as soon as possible.

For younger people or older adults without severe immunocompromise who have already had a dose in 2023, no further doses are currently recommended. Their baseline risk of severe illness is low if they have already been vaccinated, and particularly if they have also had prior infection. Therefore, a further 2023 dose will offer little additional benefit even if it has been more than 6 months since their last dose.



Pioneers of Pilgarn

Stage 1.

Citizens who built this district between years 1887 and 1914

Howlett, George: Owned the Sunbeam mine where he erected a battery in 1905 and took in When Marvel Loch was public crushings. discovered he moved his battery to the new find where he continued to take in public crushings. His battery was a lifeline for the small mines with nowhere else to crush, and was instrumental in keeping the south district going. George kept operating for many years, his nephew taking over the battery after the war and continuing to keep the district alive. The battery also provided much needed work for locals. In later years the government took it over and renamed it Marvel Loch State Battery. It banged away as the only public battery in Yilgarn, a life-line for prospecting. George Howlett's legacy to the district closed during the mid-1980's, replaced by more modern crushers when the gold boom of the 1980's and 90's took off.
