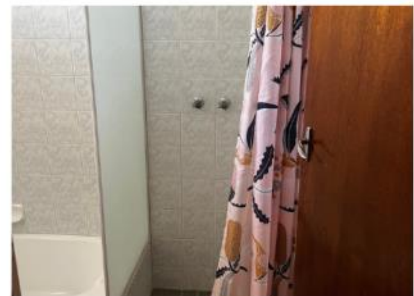

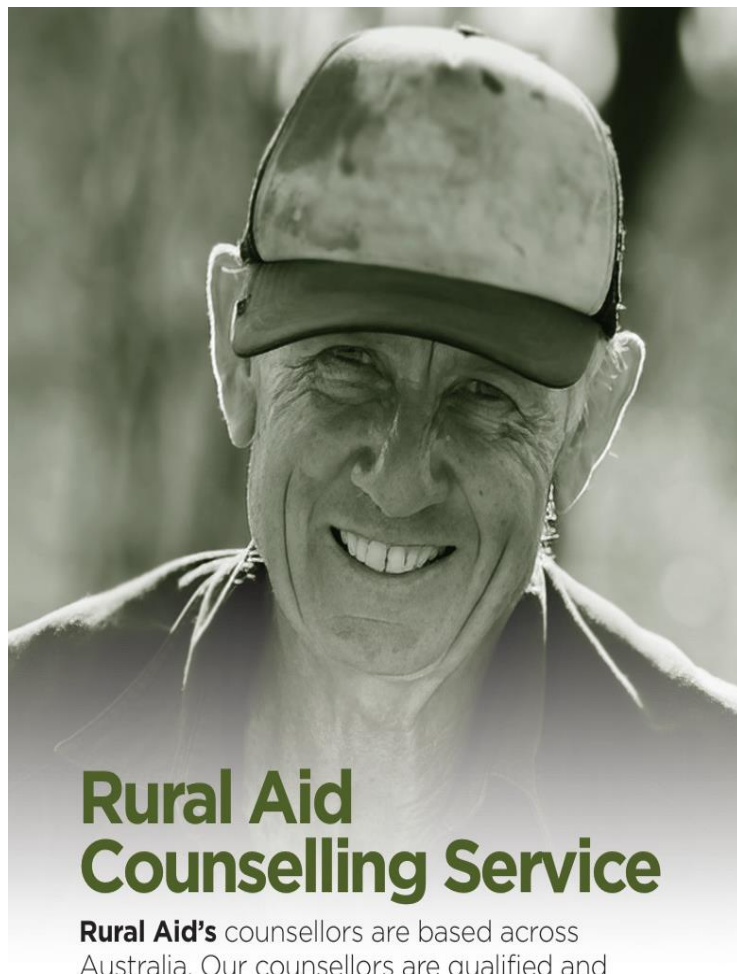

For our mates in the bush 

For our mates in the bush 

Bowled over at Bullfinch by Les Everett



My search for cricket pitches began innocently enough in October 2019. I'd played at Ardath, Babakin and Shackleton during my playing days with Corrigin from 1977 to 1980 and dropped in to see how the ovals were looking. The idea of abandoned cricket pitches was born and quickly became an obsession.

Covid-19 put a temporary end to my travels but during lockdown I discovered Google Maps as a way of locating pitches. While others dreamed of the day they could once again travel to Paris or Rome I became fixated on Moorine Rock. I could see the oval and pitch clearly on my computer screen. When free to drive I headed out on Great Eastern Highway finding and photographing 11 pitches in a day – enough for a team. At Moorine Rock I came across a group of tennis players relaxing with a drink after play. "I've just had a dream come true," I told them. They probably thought I was mad. They were right.

My hunts in the Yilgarn have revealed beautiful old pitches in paddocks in Dulyalbin and Turkey Hill, the Bodallin pitch that looks like it could be called into action at a moment's notice, and the shy pitch at Corinthia that blends in with the surroundings. I've also seen the smashed-up pitch at Marvel Loch and the



dug-up scar where the pitch was at the "new" Bullfinch oval. Play ceased there in the late 1970s when Southern Cross got grass.

At last count I'd photographed 471 pitches around WA and have probably proved my point that there are a lot around. I love them all, of course, but nothing has quite been like my recent visit to the original Bullfinch Recreation Ground.

While I can find many pitches using Google Maps and other forms of research some require local knowledge. The first indication there was more to Bullfinch came in a message from Peter Green, who grew up 200 metres east of the oval and, coincidentally, took me to a pitch laid in 1896 just south of my hometown Boulder.

Peter put me on to locals John and Raylene Roberts and then I met Andrew Parker, who owns the land that was the original recreation ground at Bullfinch and boasted two pitches in its heyday. As John and I were about to drive out into the paddock Andrew joked that the animals might be interested in what we were doing. "That would be good for the photos," I said. I have had dogs, a duck, a magpie and a kangaroo on pitches but have found cattle and sheep a bit reluctant to hang around for a photo.

At the first pitch we noticed two things. One was that nearby was a much older pitch – there were three pitches to see – and that a couple of donkeys and an alpaca were indeed very interested in coming to see us. The trio were happy to be photographed and would have been keen for a cuddle and chat too. But we had a work to do.



We'd barely arrived at the (third) pitch when they saw the little herd of cattle approaching. Soon they'd arranged themselves along the side of the pitch ready for a photo. A tap on the shoulder indicated that the donkeys had arrived too.

I left thinking Bullfinch was the best bloody pitch place in the world.

So, where to next in the Yilgarn and surrounds? I think there's pitch at Koolyanobbing, I've seen photos of the Yellowdine pitch but haven't found it yet, there might be pitches at Mt Palmer and Yerbillon (No 5 pumping station), I'm told there's one at Lake Brown and there were teams at Karalee and Yanoning Rock.

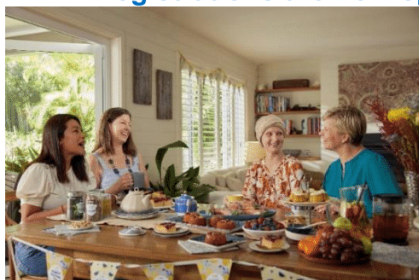
WA Federal MP's & Senators must support introduction of new vaping laws

Cancer Council WA is urging the WA community to contact [their Federal MP or Senator](#) asking them to support the introduction of new vaping laws that will assist in putting an end to the current teen vaping epidemic. Ashley Reid, Cancer Council WA's CEO, states that Federal politicians need to hear first-hand the devastating effects that vaping is having on young people.

- The figures for teen vaping are staggering. Between 2019 - 2023, vaping increased five-fold among teenagers aged 14 to 17 years
- The Federal Government plans to introduce a draft law, which, if passed, will end the domestic manufacture, supply, advertising, and commercial possession of non-therapeutic vapes
- This means people with a medical prescription would still be able to buy vapes from a pharmacy, but they would no longer be in easy reach for kids and teens
- As vaping has become more common, schools are grappling with disruptive behavioural issues and how best to support students who have unwittingly become addicted to nicotine
- We know that vaping poses serious health risks, including nicotine addiction, poisoning, seizures, burns and acute lung injuries from inhaling harmful chemicals.

Whether you are a parent, teacher, health professional or concerned member of the public, we have all witnessed the insidious uptake of vaping by young people in our community. Now is the perfect time to tell decision makers that enough is enough. We urge the WA community to download the [Cancer Council letter template](#) and email their Federal MP or Senator to let them know why this issue is so important.

Pioneers of Yilgarn

Stage 1.

Citizens who built this district between years 1887 and 1914

Lang, Sam: Sam was a forerunner in the cyanide process of removing left-over gold from old battery sands. In 1900 he teamed up with David Hatt to re-treat the dozens of tailings dumps stockpiled on every lease. The cyanide process had been borrowed from South Africa and rejuvenated Yilgarn mines for some years.

Fortune smiled when the pair witnessed two natives poking the ground with spears. The natives had discovered gold which Hatt and Lang pegged, the find becoming known as Hatt's Reward. The mine created much needed work for Southern Cross. Sam's house on lot 455 Altair Street still stands and is one of the oldest in town.

Following the Bullfinch boom, Sam moved to Golden Valley to work the old Violet mine. He also built a battery and took in public crushings. This was a boon for the small mine owners. Remains of the battery can still be seen today and is well worth a visit. Sam lived in Yilgarn for most of his life and died in 1948.

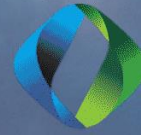
