## Pioneers of Yilgarn

Yilgarn timeline (continued)

### 1933

Voting will be compulsory in forthcoming poll under Succession Referendum Act.

SX burns as arsonists sets fire to town hall, powerhouse, wheat stacks, and a shop. Two men apprehended while lighting up Council Office and are now in jail.

The expansion of farms and mining has increased Yilgarn population to about 4,000.

Fire insurance pays for new and larger town hall and new engines for power house.

### 1934

Anzac services well attended. Fifty returned soldiers marched although some limped.

A tin coffin found underground at Cora Mine contained women's clothing styled fifty years ago. Fearing typhoid germs the clothes were burnt. What tales could they tell!

Council unable to subdivide town hall block to relieve demand for housing and shops.

Aboriginal reserve of 20 acres gazetted opposite the railway station. Whites banned.

### 1935

Box drain fronting Antares Street shops replaced by an open cement drain (still in use).

Road Board complains several shops and pubs have installed own elect power plants.

Forty five new buildings going up since Mount Palmer gold boom. Yet still a shortage.

Brick making plant installed near town (New Zealand Gully).

We would like the poster to be memorable and easy for students to recall.



We would like the tone of the PBS poster to be fun, exciting and cool.






