Great Eastern Highway—town works

Main Roads WA has advised that works on the Great Eastern highway, through the Southern Cross townsite, will commence 5 February, 2018 and will continue through to approximately 17 February, 2018.

KNOW YOUR LEGISLATION - ANIMALS

The Shire enforces state legislation and local laws relating to animals, the following details some of the requirements that commonly affect residents. For further information visit the Shires website and click on the “Animal Control” tab.

Poultry

- A person in a townsite may keep up to 20 (combined total) poultry or pigeons on their property; &
- Roosters are not permitted within townsites.

Large Animals

- Residents within townsites are not permitted to keep a horse, cow or large animal without Council approval. Large animals include pig, sheep or goat.

Dogs

- All dogs over the age of three months must be registered with the Shire and microchipped;
- Registrations are transferrable between any Western Australian local government;
- If a dog in the pound is microchipped and registered, the Shire must hold the dog for 7 days after giving notice to the known owner. After 7 days, if the animal is not claimed, it is either rehomed via A1 Wheatbelt Animal Rescue, or destroyed as a last resort;
- If a dog in the pound is not microchipped or registered and the owner is not known, the Shire only holds the dog for 72 hours, if an owner is not identified, the dog is either rehomed via A1 Wheatbelt Animal Rescue or destroyed. It is therefore important to make sure your dog is microchipped and registered;
- A dog shall not be in a public place unless it is held by a person who is capable of controlling the dog or the dog is securely tethered;
- A dog in a public place must wear a collar with its Shire issued registration tag attached;
- A maximum of 2 dogs are allowed per property within townsites or 4 dogs outside of townsites, unless permitted otherwise by Council.

Cats

- All cats over 6 months of age must be registered with the Shire, must wear a Shire issued tag when in public; must be microchipped and must be sterilised;
- Only cats owned by an approved breeder, or have received an exemption from a veterinarian; or are a class of cat that is exempt may be unsterilised over the age of 6 months;
- If a cat in the pound is microchipped and registered, the Shire must hold the cat for 7 working days after giving notice to the known owner. Once the 7 days is up, if the animal is not claimed, it is either rehomed via A1 Wheatbelt Animal Rescue, or destroyed as a last resort;
- If a cat is not microchipped or registered and the owner is not known, the Shire only holds the cat for 3 working days, if an owner is not identified, the cat is either rehomed via A1 Wheatbelt Animal Rescue or destroyed as a last resort;
- If a cat in the pound is thought to be feral, diseased or dangerous and has or may cause injury or illness to a person, other animal or itself, the animal may be destroyed immediately;
- The Shire has a feral cat issue, and is currently trapping around Southern Cross. If your cat is caught and is not microchipped and shows no signs of being domesticated, it is likely to be deemed feral and destroyed immediately, to avoid this, microchip your cat and have it registered;
- A person may not keep more than three cats over the age of 3 months on any premises, unless Council has granted an exemption;

Nuisances

- A resident that keeps any permitted animal must make sure it does not cause a nuisance to neighbours. Nuisances may be odour, noise, dust or any other nuisance as deemed by the Shires Authorised Officers.

Pioneers of Yilgarn

Stage 1.

**Citizens who built this district between years
1887 and 1914**

Horan, : Appointed railway station master Southern Cross when the government took over the recently built line in July 1894. Being the inaugural station master he was tasked with getting the station up and running. As well as Southern Cross traffic, train loads of material for a fledgling Coolgardie and Kalgoorlie arrived daily for onwards despatch by horse and camel teams. Four hundred teamsters operated out of Southern Cross. A year later Horan had to deal with the goods shed burning down. In 1896 the railway line was extended onwards to Kalgoorlie, which increased the station master's responsibilities with crew working. Southern Cross was the only depot between Northam and Kalgoorlie. Later, more depots were introduced en-route which reduced the work-load. At one time 100 men were employed at Southern Cross.

What is the HEAL™ Program?

The FREE Healthy Eating Activity and Lifestyle (HEAL™) Program helps people develop lifelong healthy lifestyle habits. It takes a non-diet approach to weight management and aims to educate all clients about evidence base and change mindsets towards the gimmicks, fads and weight loss misconceptions.

Who Can Participate in the HEAL™ Program?

HEAL™ is open to people to help manage their weight, type II diabetes or heart disease (including high blood pressure or high cholesterol).

What Does the HEAL™ Program Involve?

HEAL™ runs for 2 hour sessions across 8 weeks. The groups are friendly and supportive and involve:

- 1 hour of gentle exercise and
- 1 hour of lifestyle and nutrition education.

It also includes four individual health consultations.



Who Runs the HEAL™ Program?

The Program is co-facilitated by Claire our Dietitian and Zoe our Health Promotion Officer. A multidisciplinary approach is taken with input from our Physiotherapists for tailored exercises.



When Does the HEAL™ Program Run?

The program was piloted in Merredin in 2017 and 12 participants completed the full 8 weeks! More programs are planned for 2018. The location and time is to be confirmed.

What is the Referral Process?

Self-refer by calling Eastern Wheatbelt Primary Health on 9041 0444 or request a referral from your GP.



MERREDIN HEAL WRAP-UP

The Healthy Eating Activity and Lifestyle (HEAL) Program was piloted in Merredin in 2017. Here are some initial results.



12 PARTICIPANTS

aged from 26-77 years completed the full 8 week program.

TOP 3 CHRONIC CONDITIONS WERE:

Type II Diabetes

HEAL PROGRAM INVOLVED:



8 HOURS of group education led by Dietitian and Health Promotion.

8 HOURS of group exercise with visits from an Exercise Physiologist.

2 HOURS at Merredin Gym learning to correctly use equipment.

4 individual health assessments at weeks 1, 8, 20 and 52.

AT 8 WEEKS THE HEAL PARTICIPANTS:



Had a total weight loss of **4.3KG**.

Total loss of **27.5CM** around their waist and **10CM** around their hips.

Increased their planned weekly physical activity by an average of **2 HOURS**.

Increased weekly fruit and vegetable intake to an average of **2 FRUIT** and **3 VEG**.

Increased the distance completed in the 6 minute walk test by average of **43M**.

Healthy Country Kids Ears Health



Eastern Wheatbelt Primary Health Service is excited to announce our new Healthy Country Kids Ears Clinic! This clinic is open to all children living in the Eastern Wheatbelt.

Otitis media (middle ear infections) can begin within weeks of birth and can recur into adolescence and adulthood. If left untreated middle ear infections can lead to hearing loss, developmental and learning delays. This program will work in screening, treatment, self-management and prevention of future infections and complications.

This is a FREE service that will use telehealth to link you with Ear Nose and Throat specialists at Princess Margaret Hospital, allowing for a specialist appointment for your child without needing to travel to Perth.


