MAIN ROADS WA – WHEATBELT REGION

Main Roads WA – Wheatbelt Region has provided the following advice to the Shire of Yilgarn in respect to sections on the Great Eastern Highway and Marvel Loch Road within the Shire of Yilgarn which are presenting frequent potholes.

"On Marvel Loch Road we will be carrying out a full reseal of the road in around Feb/Mar 2019. In May and June 2018 we undertook crack sealing works. Prior to the reseal we will be carrying out surface repairs (taking the existing seal off and making the road smooth) in two sections that are frequently getting potholes (between 11km and 14km and between 18km and 20km outside of Southern Cross).

On alternative weeks, the road is inspected and a routine maintenance crew undertakes repairs. This ensures the road is being monitored every week. Routine crews have been managing the defects within their fortnightly visits and there have been over 30 repairs performed in the past 2 months. Due to the upcoming planned works we believe maintenance is being carried out to a satisfactory level.

On Great Eastern Highway between Merredin and Walgoolan there are several areas that are showing an increased frequency of potholes. We are currently considering including these areas in the 2018/19 reseal program. Both a routine maintenance crew and an inspector visit these sections weekly and approximately 80 potholes have been fixed so far this winter".



Board Membership – Call for nominations

The Wheatbelt Development Commission is seeking nominations to fill one community position on the Wheatbelt Development Commission Board.

The Wheatbelt Development Commission is a Statutory Authority established under the *Regional Development Commissions Act 1993*. Its purpose is to promote balanced economic and social development in the Wheatbelt region.

Its objectives include maximising job creation, broadening local economies, identifying the need for infrastructure and services, providing information and advice to business and ensuring equitable access to government services. The Wheatbelt Development Commission also promotes and facilitates effective partnerships between government and regional communities.

The Commission is seeking nominations from highly motivated and enthusiastic people, who can demonstrate the following:

- Understand key issues impacting the development of the Region;
- Demonstrate involvement in either the economic, and/or social development of the Region; and
- The ability to work cooperatively to achieve agreed goals across a wide range of issues and stakeholders.

People may nominate themselves or others, organisations may also nominate individuals. Terms of appointment will be from one to three years. To be eligible for the community positions, nominees must live in the Wheatbelt region.

The Minister for Regional Development, Hon Alannah MacTiernan MLC will make the appointment to the Board after consultation with WA state cabinet.

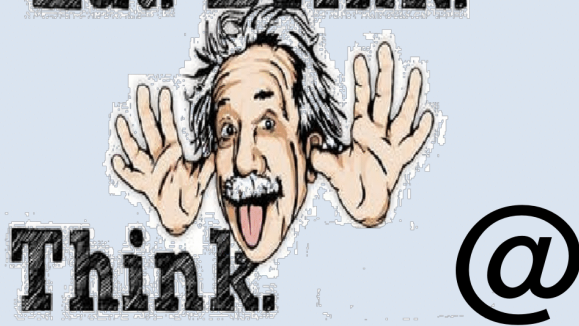

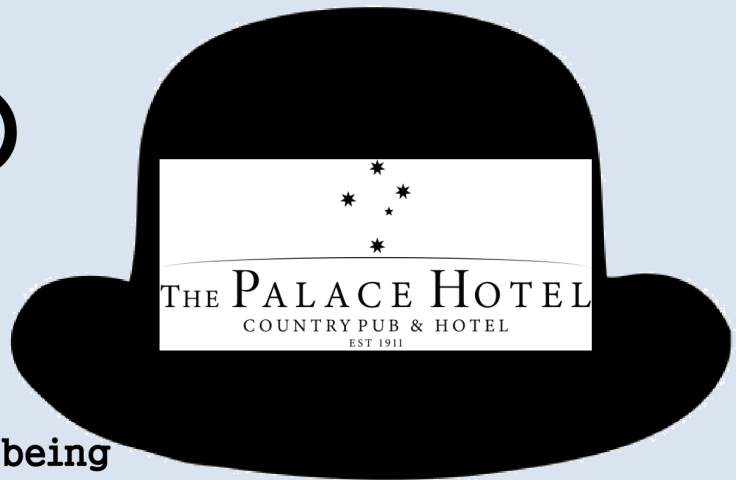

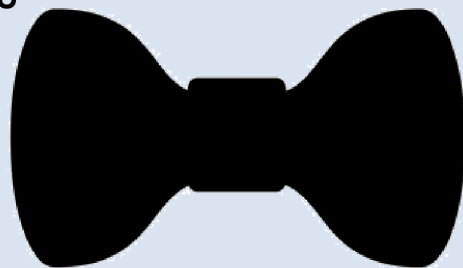

Martin, William: An important water contractor employed by Council to watch over New Zealand Gully town water supply, and be accountable for usage. He carted water to Southern Cross by spring cart and hawked it around town. He also kept several tanks in the main street full for firefighting. When the goldfields pipe arrived in 1902 he was contracted to watch over the standpipe and be accountable for usage and collection of charges, prior to the town being reticulated a year later.

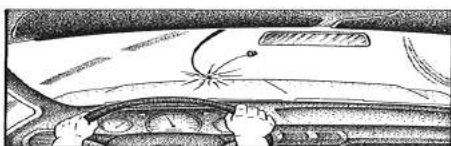
