



## SHIRE OF YILGARN CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER APPOINTMENT

Following an exhaustive process in the appointment of a new CEO for the Shire of Yilgarn, Council at its Ordinary meeting held on Thursday, 16 August 2018 resolved to appoint Mr Peter Clarke to the position on a three (3) Contract.

The Shire President, Cr Onida Truran, issued the following statement:-

"I am pleased to advise that Council has now added some stability in its Executive Management team by appointing Peter Clarke as its new CEO. This followed a period of approximately 12 months where Council had been appointing people in Acting CEO capacities, which was not an ideal scenario.

Peter is well known in the Yilgarn district having served as our CEO on two other separate occasions, a period totalling 12 years of service with the Shire of Yilgarn. Peter was appointed as Acting CEO in April 2018 during which time Council undertook a second round of recruitment processes. Whilst Peter did not initially intend to apply for the CEO position, we were delighted that he did in the end. We welcome Peter back into the fold.

I would like to especially thank all of our staff for the way in which they have coped during this period of instability. Councillors, staff and indeed the community now look forward to a period of consolidation in the administrative area of Council's operations."





**McDonald, Hugh:** Was one of the largest pastoralists in Yilgarn, leasing country from Yellowdine to Strawberry Rock in the early 1900's to run sheep and cattle. He was a pioneer of the industry.

Without today's fences, losses to wild dogs was considerable, as was cattle hit by trains, and cattle poisoned by cyanide water around the mines. McDonald also owned a butcher's shop in Southern Cross.

After the First World War his pastoral land was resumed by the government and surveyed into farms to become Miners Settlement.

#### Volunteer Grants 2018 - open for application

The Australian Government is inviting applications via an open process to apply for funding to support volunteers under the <u>Volunteer Grants Activity</u> (https://www.communitygrants.gov.au/grants/volunteer-grants-2018).

Volunteer Grants aim to support the efforts of Australia's volunteers by:

- providing small amounts of money that organisations and community groups can use to help their volunteers
- forming part of the Government's work to support the volunteers who help disadvantaged Australian communities and encourage inclusion of vulnerable people in community life.

The Volunteer Grants 2018 funding round will provide funding of between \$1,000 and \$5,000 to eligible individuals and not-for-profit community organisations. This funding is to be used to:

- purchase eligible small equipment items for use by volunteers
- contribute to volunteers' fuel costs
- contribute to transport costs for volunteers with disability who are unable to drive
- assist with the costs of training courses
- undertake background screening checks for volunteers

Applications close at 2:00 pm AEST on 18 September 2018.

#### Harvest Mass Management Scheme (HMMS) – New Arrangements for 2018-2019 Harvest

Changes to the HMMS will continue to allow for "first and last" mile access on roads between the paddock and the nearest road approved for RAV network access. The HMMS operates from Monday, 1 October 2018 to Thursday, 28 February next year.

The new arrangements are that prior to harvest a farmer or transport operator must submit to Main Roads WA a HMMS Road List form identifying the intended RAV combination and a list of roads being used from the paddock to the approved RAV network.

Main Roads WA will conduct a desktop assessment of the HMMS Road List and the route will be endorsed with operating conditions if considered safe.

The road list must be endorsed by Main Roads WA before commencing HMMS operations for the 2018 -2019 harvest and the road list must be carried in the vehicle and produced on request to Main Roads WA, WA Police or the grain handler. The endorsed list may be shared by other transport operators.

#### Australian National Flag Day – 3 September

All Australians are encouraged to fly or display the flag on 3 September each year. It is an opportunity for individuals, community organisations, local authorities, businesses and schools to celebrate with pride the anniversary of the Australian National Flag, the symbol of our nation.

#### **AUSTRALIAN NATIONAL FLAG**

The Australian National Flag (the flag) was first flown in 1901 (see also Australian National Flag Day). It is Australia's foremost national symbol and has become an expression of Australian identity and pride.

The flag is paraded by our defence forces and displayed around the country at sporting events and by service organisations, schools, community groups and private citizens.

#### **SYMBOLISM**

The flag has three elements on a blue background: the Union Jack, the Commonwealth Star and the Southern Cross.

The Union Jack in the upper left corner represents the history of British settlement.

Below the Union Jack is a white Commonwealth, or Federation, star. It has seven points representing the unity of the six states and the territories of the Commonwealth of Australia. The star is also featured on the Commonwealth Coat of Arms.

The Southern Cross is shown on the flag in white. It is a constellation of five stars that can only be seen from the southern hemisphere and is a reminder of Australia's geography.

#### **HISTORY**

In 1901 Australia's first Prime Minister, the Rt Hon Sir Edmund Barton, announced an international competition to design a flag for the new Commonwealth of Australia. There were 32,823 entries and five nearly-identical entries were awarded equal first.

The flag was flown for the first time in September 1901 at the Exhibition Building in Melbourne, which was then the seat of the federal government originally governed. In this original design the stars of the Southern Cross had different numbers of points to signify their brightness

An amendment to the Flags Act 1953 was passed in 1998 to ensure that the Australian National Flag can be changed only with the agreement of the Australian people.

Other official Australian flags include the Australian Aboriginal Flag, the Torres Strait Islander Flag and the ensigns of the Australian Defence Force.


