SHIRE OF YILGARN COUNCIL NEWS UPDATE

Australian Government's Local Roads and Community Infrastructure (LRCI) Funding

The Shire President, Cr Wayne Della Bosca, reported in the Budget 2020/2021 Newsletter that Council had submitted the following projects for approval under the Australian Government's LRCI Funding program following a consultation period with the community on priority projects:-

Swimming Pool Covers	\$ 60,000
Upgrade Constellation and Rotary Park BBQ's	\$ 24,000
Yilgarn Homes for the Aged Courtyards	\$169,500
Skatepark	\$220,000
Beaton Road Upgrade and Footpath to Cemetery	\$370,000
Construction Turning Lane – Bennett/Moorine Rock South Roads	\$100,000

Council has now been advised by the Australian Government's Department of Infrastructure, Transport, Regional Development and Communications that the above projects have been approved. Council will start commencement for planning and construction, with all projects due for completion prior to June 2021.

Southern Cross Aquatic Centre Project – OPENING DATE CONFIRMED

The project is certainly taking shape and the Contractors, Cooper & Oxley, have reported that the Centre is on schedule to be completed by mid-November 2020, with an Official Opening date now confirmed for **Saturday, 28 November 2020**. More information on the format for the Opening of the facility will be advised in future editions of Crosswords.

Mineral Resources Ltd. (MRL) has been kind enough to assist Council with funding for the purchase of new outdoor cricket nets and top-up funding to purchase quality pool blankets as part of this project. The blankets will ensure that an additional month of opening is achieved either side of the swimming season. **MRL's contribution is much appreciated by the Shire of Yilgarn.**

Wheatbelt Cash for Containers

With the introduction of a Container Deposit Scheme (CDS) in Western Australia, Council granted approval at its August 2020 Ordinary meeting for "Wheatbelt Cash for Containers" to operate the scheme in Southern Cross. Ms Pauline Guest, proprietor of

"Wheatbelt Cash for Containers", will be placing small garden shed type containers for the depositing of containers eligible for refunds initially at the Southern Cross Recreation Ground near the cardboard recycling bins, with them eventually being located between the Tennis Courts and Senior Citizens Centre.

More advertising will take place in *Crosswords* as to how the CDS will work and how you will be able to collect refunds on eligible containers.

Shire of Yilgarn Tourism Advisory Committee Re-formation

During the development of the Shire of Yilgarn Community Strategic Planning process, it was identified at a community workshop that the Shire of Yilgarn should be placing additional emphasis on the promotion of the district from a tourism related perspective and that Council should reform the Tourism Advisory Committee.

As a result of this feedback, Council when adopting the Shire of Yilgarn Community Strategic Plan 2020-2030 at its June 2020 Ordinary meeting, resolved to re-establish the Committee. Expressions of Interest were called for community members to be members of the Advisory Committee and at the August 2020 Council meeting, the following community members were appointed:-

Leonie Gethin, Robin Stevens, Kaye Crafter, Charles Jenkins, Ken Fairless, Kerry Fairless, Gary Kenward, Alison Carnicelli, Shannon Carnicelli, Jess Stephens, Laura Black, Ron Goodhill.

The re-formed Committee conducted its first meeting on Wednesday, 2 September 2020.

Bodallin Hall

With minimal use over a number of years, Council had earmarked in its 2020/2021 Budget for the possible demolition of the Bodallin Hall. Prior to a decision being made, Council considered it prudent to liaise with the Bodallin community seeking their feedback on this proposal. An overwhelming majority of the feedback received favoured retention of the Hall.

Therefore, Council at its August 2020 Ordinary meeting resolved to allocate the funds identified for demolition to re-connection of power to the Hall. The Bodallin Community Hall Committee will also have to contribute funds to make the building safe for community use. The Bodallin community has been granted a timeframe in which to demonstrate usage of the Hall otherwise Council will re-consider demolition at a future time.

Mineral Resources Ltd (MRL) – Trading as Yilgarn Iron Pty Ltd (YIPL) – Parkers Range Project

Council and staff have been working closely with YIPL regarding its new iron ore mine at Parkers Range south of Marvel Loch. Negotiations have been ongoing regarding the upgrade of the Emu Fence Road to a bitumen standard from the Parkers Range Road, north to the Great Eastern Highway for ore haulage at YIPL's cost. A similar bitumen road north of the Great Eastern Highway will also be constructed by YIPL to the Southern Cross-Koolyanobbing Road.

Due to issues associated with the construction of the northern section of the Emu Fence Road, YIPL has been in discussions with Council regarding a temporary route for the haulage of their ore.

Council has favoured the upgrade of Rogers Road, east of the Southern Cross townsite to accommodate the additional truck movements which will alleviate the amount of additional amount of truck movements going through the Southern Cross townsite on the Great Eastern Highway.

The existing Parkers Range Road dissects the newly created mine and to ensure that access on Parkers Range Road continues between Emu Fence Road and Marvel Loch -Forrestania Road, YIPL is required to construct a deviation road around the mine site. Council is currently undertaking an advertising process and notice to affected persons calling for submissions in respect to the proposed deviation. Submissions close on Monday, 12 October 2020 at 4.00pm.

YIPL is in the process of developing a 100 person Mine Camp on the corner of Burbidge and Emu Fence Road to accommodate workers at the mine site.

YIPL is also planning to utilise the Southern Cross Airstrip for FIFO operations associated with the Parkers Range Project. Currently FIFO workers are landing at YIPL's East Jaurdi airstrip and are having to be bussed to the Parkers Range site. By utilising the Southern Cross Airstrip, it will significantly reduce transportation for YIPL's FIFO employees. It is anticipated that flights will commence on 1 October 2020.

Applications for the following categories are invited:

Did You Know?

Did you know that Southern Cross was chosen for a Flying Training School during the Second World War? A thousand men were to be stationed here. The all-powerful Military resumed 1300 acres of Forrester's farm in 1940, and spent the next six months wrecking it: thousands of pounds were spent clearing shade trees, removing fences, filling in dams, levelling paddocks by dragging railway lines, and rolling roads and building sites until the soil was hard as concrete.

Concrete foundations several feet high were everywhere. Then work stopped overnight. The Military said the morrell country was too dusty, lake country with its thermals a problem for trainees, and Southern Cross a ghost town as far as recreation for staff. More likely the theatre of war by this stage had shifted further north.

The Training School was moved to Geraldton, while Southern Cross and Bill Forrester were left lamenting. For years afterwards Southern Cross was blanketed with dust from Forrester's farm when easterlies blew. It took a long time for the area to be rehabilitated, and longer for Forrester to be compensated by the government for wrecking the best part of his farm.

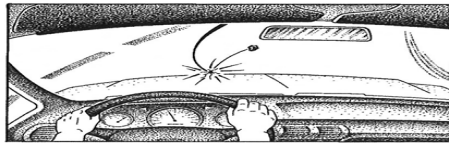
