PROPOSED PLANNING POLICY

The Shire of Yilgarn Council has resolved to endorse the Draft Policy 4.9 - **Transportable Dwellings and Additional Rural-Mining Dwellings Policy**. Council gives notice of the proposed policy in accordance with Section 87 of the Planning and Development Act 2005.

The proposed policy exempts the current requirement to seek Council approval for the installation of a single new transportable dwelling on a townsite lot within the district, and to exempt the requirement to seek Council approval for additional dwellings on a single lot for Rural/Mining zoned land.

The objective of the proposed policy is to reduce development-associated red tape for landowners in the Yilgarn district and to speed up the approval process.

Assessment Criteria:

Preference will be given to landholders who haven't received many/any Shire projects in the past.

- Species must be planted to tackle poor production areas (issues such as salinity, wind erosion, or other 'land degradation matters').
- Saltbush Seedlings will be delivered on-farm during late June/early July 2021. Applicants **must** be able to accept, care for (water every day) and plant seedlings at any time within this period.
- Stock **must** be kept off seedlings for the first 12 months.

Planting information:

Seedlings should be planted in blocks or belts at 1000 (up to 1200) stems/ha depending on soil capacity and layout. There should be barley grass present as indicator that the species will survive on intended site.

Seedling Information:

The Shire of Yilgarn is proposing that a subsidy of 25 cents per seedling be paid by the receiving landholder to help offset the costs involved (each Oldman and Oil Mallee seedling costs 58 cents). Oldman Saltbush is native to the semi-arid areas of Australia and is well adapted to conditions.

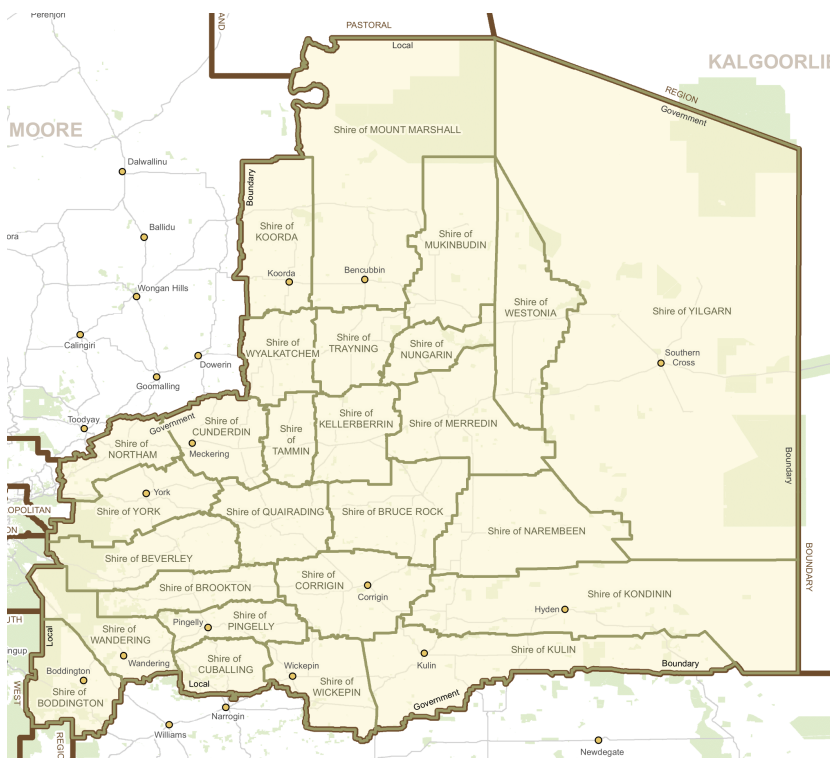

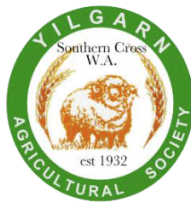

Did You Know?

Did you know how difficult it was to get our swimming pool? Southern Cross Swimming Pool had its genesis at a public meeting held in January 1956. Bill Nicholson the shire president presided over 52 people. Des Ferris shire secretary spoke on the cost and plans.

A committee was formed. However in June 1956 Great Western Consolidated announced its intention of building a pool at Bullfinch. This was a tremendous setback but the committee struggled on. Nine months after the first meeting £1000 was lodged in the bank. However a poll conducted on the proposed loan of £10,000 met with a negative response from ratepayers.

The committee felt a lack of support from the Road Board and ratepayers alike, and decided to go into recession for 12 months, a period which stretched to 2½ years. A public meeting in 1961 resolved that the committee be held responsible for raising money, while the Shire be responsible for constructing the pool.

Committee members gritted their teeth and hung on through bad times, doing their bit to raise the money needed. They felt proud of their achievement when the pool was finally opened in 1963, and the public grateful for a job well done on their behalf.

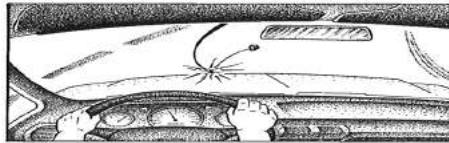
