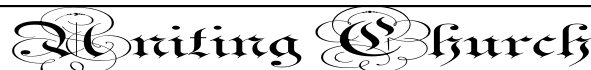

Did You Know?

Did you know that our local cemetery is one of the best kept in WA. In 1905 Albert Paul Tonkin aged 25 was killed in a mining accident, and his remains interred in Southern Cross cemetery.

His widow taught at the school for a few years before moving on, but not before erecting a headstone and iron railing around the grave.

In 1963 his daughter visited the cemetery expecting to find her father's grave in a state of neglect and disrepair. She was deeply gratified to find that everything was in good order with the iron railings painted.

During a CWA conference in Perth, this lady sought out our Southern Cross delegate to ask her to convey to the authority concerned the deep gratitude of her family for their attention and care of her father's grave.

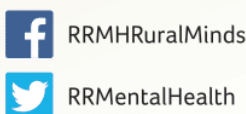

Influenza Vaccine Immunisation for 2021

We are pleased to advise that we have government funded influenza vaccines in stock. Eligible persons can now book an appointment. Please note, if you have had a COVID-19 vaccine, remember to give 14 days in between before having your influenza vaccine and visa versa.

Eligibility for government-funded seasonal influenza vaccine for 2021

- persons 65 years or older
- children 6 months to less than 5 years
- primary school-aged children (from 5 years to students in year 6)
- pregnant women (any trimester)
- Aboriginal people 6 months and older
- individuals 6 months and older with medical conditions that place them at risk for complications of influenza, including:
 - cardiac disease
 - chronic respiratory conditions
 - chronic neurological conditions
 - impaired immunity
 - diabetes and other metabolic disorders
 - renal disease
 - haematological disorders
 - children aged 6 months to 10 years receiving long-term aspirin therapy.

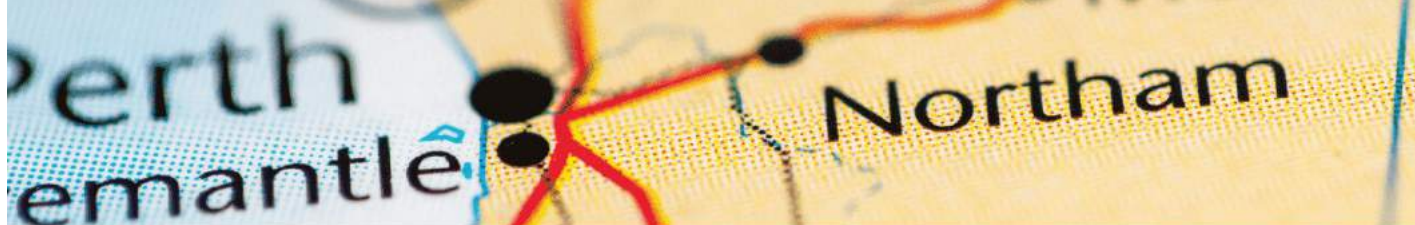

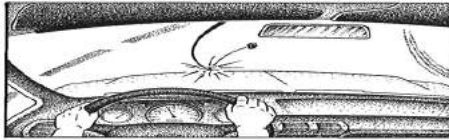
