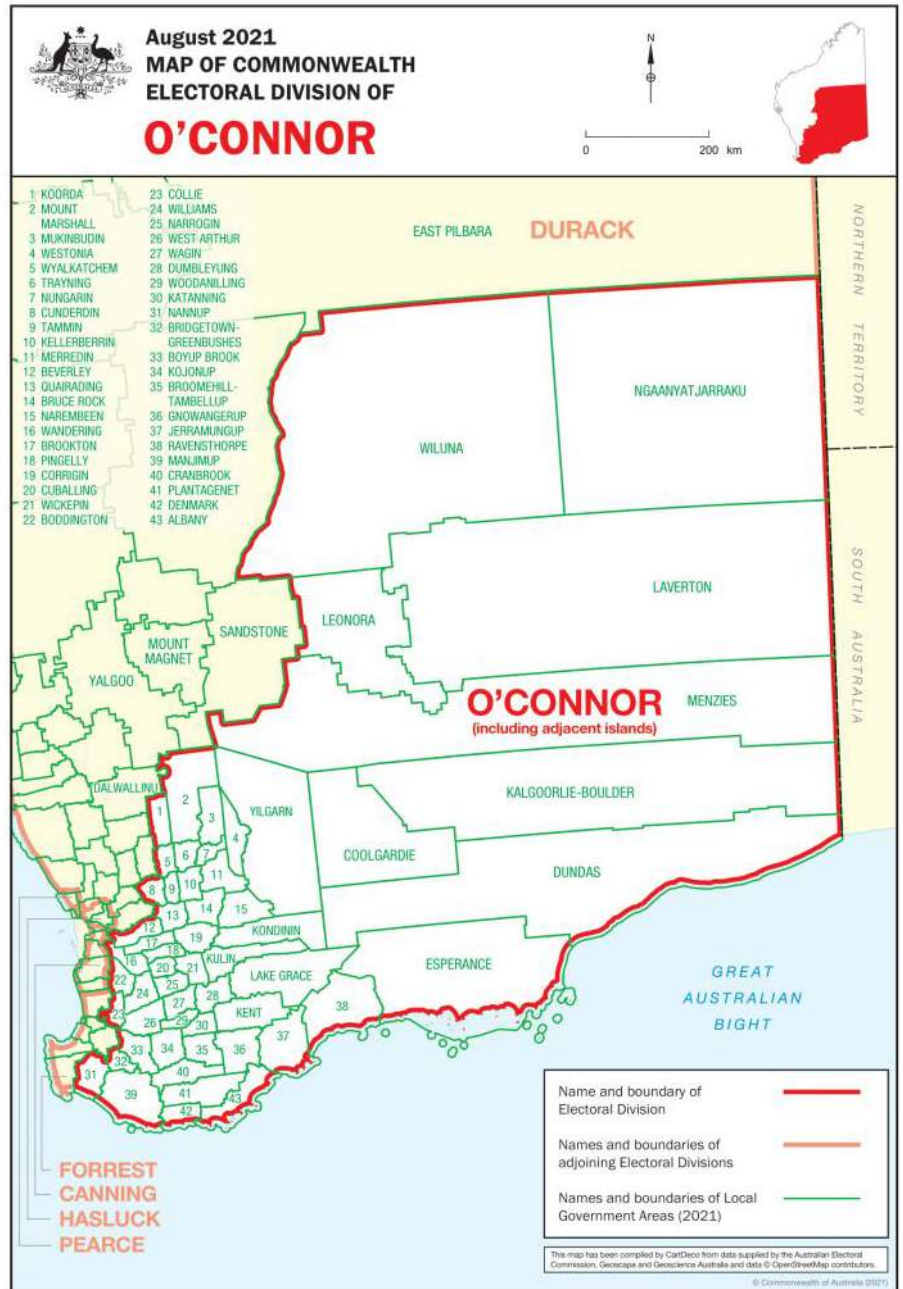

Southern Cross Airfield Usage Logger Successful Trial

In May 2021 Council commenced a trial of hardware that recorded the usage (landing and departures) of the Southern Cross Aerodrome. This trial was successful with the necessary recording hardware being acquired by Council.

With the new financial year about to commence, all locally based users of the Southern Cross Aerodrome are reminded that you have two options for paying for the use of the aerodrome, these are pay an annual fee of \$165.00 which is only available to aircraft owners based within the Shire of Yilgarn or be charged on a per use basis (currently calculated at \$17.50 per tonne per movement).

If you elect to make the annual contribution, please contact Council's Executive Manager Corporate Services on 08 9049 1001 to provide your aircraft's registration details, an invoice will be issued and your aircraft's details will be forwarded to Avdata, the billing authority.

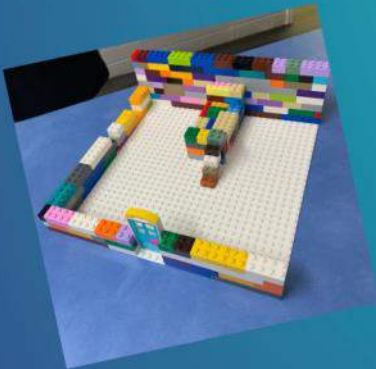
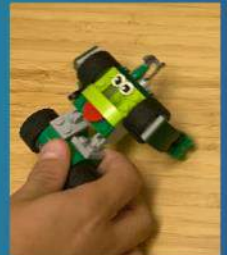

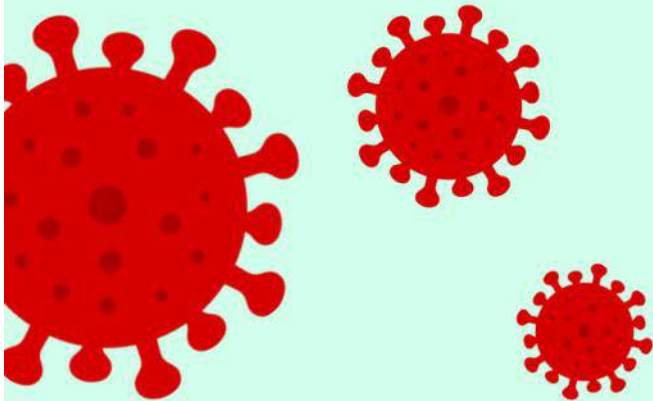

Assessment Criteria:

Preference will be given to landholders who haven't received many/any Shire projects in the past.

- Species must be planted to tackle poor production areas (issues such as salinity, wind erosion, or other 'land degradation matters').
- Pasture seed must be purchased & planted within the financial year of 22/23. Proof of purchase to be shown. Planting timing may be weather-determined.
- Saltbush Seedlings will be delivered on-farm early July 2022. Applicants **must** be able to accept, care for (water every day) and plant seedlings at any time within this period.
- Stock **must** be kept off seedlings for the first 12 months.

Planting information:

Seedlings should be planted in blocks or belts at 1000 stems/ha depending on soil capacity and layout. There should be barley grass present as indicator that the species will survive on intended site.

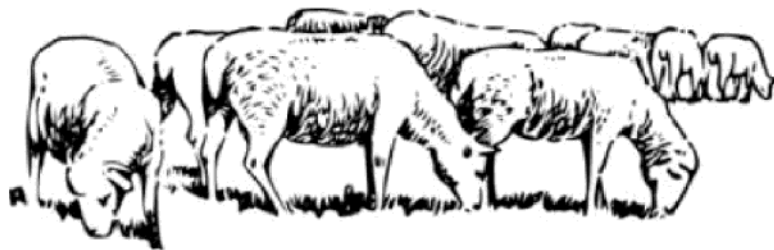
Seedling Information:

The Shire of Yilgarn is proposing that a subsidy of 30 cents per seedling be paid by the receiving landholder to help offset the costs involved (each seedling costs 60 cents). Oldman Saltbush is native to the semi-arid areas of Australia and is well adapted to conditions. Yilgarn Mallee. Oil mallee and Gimlet are native and great for wind breaks for stock protection and reducing soil erosion.

Influenza Vaccination Program for 2022

Annual Influenza vaccination is the most important measure to prevent influenza and its complications. During the COVID-19 pandemic, there has been reduced circulation of influenza virus and lower levels of influenza vaccine coverage compared with previous years. With borders reopening, a resurgence of influenza is expected in 2022.

Government funded influenza vaccinations are in stock at the practice. Appointments can be booked now.

Eligibility for government funded influenza vaccines in WA are:

- persons 65 years or older
- children 6 months to less than 10 years
- pregnant women (any trimester)
- Aboriginal people 6 months and older
- individuals 6 months and older with medical conditions that place them at risk for complications of influenza, including:
 - o cardiac disease
 - o chronic respiratory conditions
 - o chronic neurological conditions
 - o Immunocompromising conditions
 - o diabetes and other metabolic disorders
 - o renal disease
 - o haematological disorders
 - o children aged 6 months to 10 years receiving long term aspirin therapy.

HELP STOP FLU FROM SPREADING

Good hygiene practices, such as washing your hands thoroughly with soap and warm water can assist with reducing the risk of infection.

Did you know?

Did you know that Goodin's picture theatre opened in December 1928, with the main reel being 'Charlie Chaplin.' It was built by Arthur Goodin, dimensions 87 feet by 38 feet, with walls 19 feet high. The stage accommodated the screen. Tiered flooring at the rear allowed a clear vision for all. Sound curtains hung along the walls. A fireproof room on stilts outside the hall at the rear contained the projection equipment. The hall was built crossways across several blocks: lots 39 and 38c. Prior to building their own hall, the Goodin family operated pictures from the Mechanics hall. Southern Cross was booming in those days with hundreds of new land settlers developing farms in the district. Later a picture garden was added alongside the hall for summer showing. If it rained there was a dash to get inside the hall, and wait for the reels to be set up again and the picture restart. It was good fun. Mrs Goodin manned the ticket box, her brother Wally Davies manned the door, while Arthur Goodin and son Jim operated the two projectors. A local fireman was always in attendance, and I vowed to join the fire brigade when old enough so as to see the pictures for free. Dances were also held in the hall, as well as school concerts. Double feature movies were screened on Wednesday's and Friday's and Saturdays, and a single feature on Sundays. At interval most went outside for a smoke or an ice-cream. The films came from Perth by rail. The first occasion a 3-D movie was screened, characters 'leaping' out of the screen had the audience gasping. It was a sad day in December 1965 when pictures were transferred to the newly built Drive-In theatre on Constellation Park. Then came television, and movie pictures faded away at Southern Cross.

NOTICE OF BAITING PROGRAM FOR WILD DOGS

The Eastern Wheatbelt Biosecurity Group (EWBG) advises that from January 1st 2022 ongoing, heavy baiting programs (using 1080 meat baits) to control wild dogs will be carried out by Licensed Pest Management Technicians on Unallocated Crown Land to the east of the State Barrier Fence. In addition to 1080 baiting programs, technicians will be using foot hold traps treated with Strychnine to remove Wild Dogs that are currently impacting the livestock industry in the EWBG region.

From January 1st 2022, the standard wild dog control methods will be ongoing and this may include setting of traps and dispersing of 1080 meat baits in the groups operational area.

The poison baits will remain toxic for a number of months or until substantial rainfall is received. People are advised to take care when working within or visiting these areas.

Warning signs have been placed where applicable on Unallocated Crown Land and main access roads.

Picnic sites and recreational reserves are **not** included within the baiting program; however, baiting may take place adjacent to such areas and domestic pets should be kept close and under control at all times.

1080 baiting is an integral part of the wild dog pest management program to protect livestock from death and injury caused by wild dogs.



Exercise caution to prevent your pets from being poisoned by 1080 baits.



If a wild dog is sighted, please report to the Eastern Wheatbelt Biosecurity Group immediately.



If poisoning occurs, contact a doctor or Poisons Information Centre (phone 13 11 26).

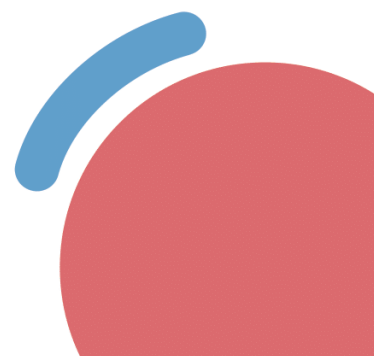
