It was great to see so many enjoying the warm weather at the beautiful Constellation Park facilities.

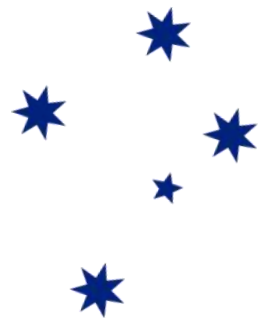
Congratulations go to our Shire of Yilgarn Active Citizenship award winners for 2023, **David Pasini and Toby Hilder**

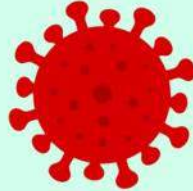

"The park is a real plus for the kids in town and future generations of kids"

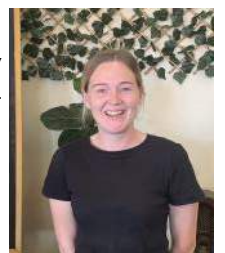

Pioneers of Yilgarn

Stage 1.

Citizens who built this district between years 1887 and 1914

Carroll family: Accompanied by his wife, Jack Carroll was an early arrival at Southern Cross, building a boarding house of 12 rooms plus a dwelling of 5 rooms on lot 38. Boarding houses were popular with the single men and the Carroll's provided some stability in their lives. With the absence of fresh vegetables and meat, the Carroll's grew their own for the kitchen. Pigs roamed the yard. Jack also had a carrying business which kept him busy. In 1902 they sold the property and the new owner pulled down the original building and built the present two-story boarding house on the same site.

Clamp, George: Came to Southern Cross in 1889 to become the best known sandalwood cutter in the district. He was helped by his sons. Sandalwood was Yilgarn's first industry, years before gold was discovered. It was sandalwood cutters like George Clamp who opened up the inland and cut the early tracks and found the waterholes. Cutters lived in the bush for months, cutting and carting the spindly trees for export to Asian countries where the wood was burnt for incense. George Clamp and his sons were also active in mining, particularly around Golden Valley. Clampton goldfield near Mount Jackson was found by one of his sons. Pioneer George Clamp died in 1925 after a wagon accident.
