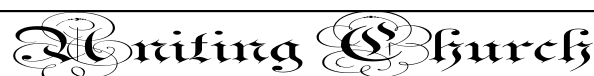

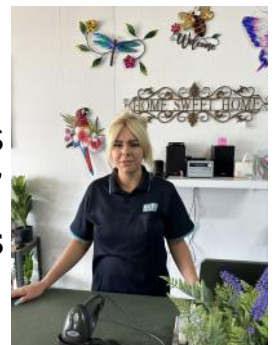

Pioneers of Yilgarn

Stage 1.

Citizens who built this district between years 1887 and 1914

Coward, John: Came to Nevoria in 1905 to work as an electrician for David Hatt, owner of Never-Never (Nevoria) mine. Electricity was in its infancy at that stage. Coward remained in the south region for some years, working on the Democrat, Lady Agnes, and Francis Furniss mines.

When the south region was opened to farming in 1927 he took up a thousand acres, and with the help of his sons Sid, Bill, and Ted cleared the land. He cleared right up to the road verge as was the practise, and applied to the Road Board for discounted rates as payment. The Road Board refused as he had not applied for permission prior to doing the job.

During the depression years, Coward was one of the many who forfeited his farm, afterwards pulling sandalwood and cutting timber for a living. His sons were noted wood cutters and good citizens. Descendants of John Coward still reside in Southern Cross.

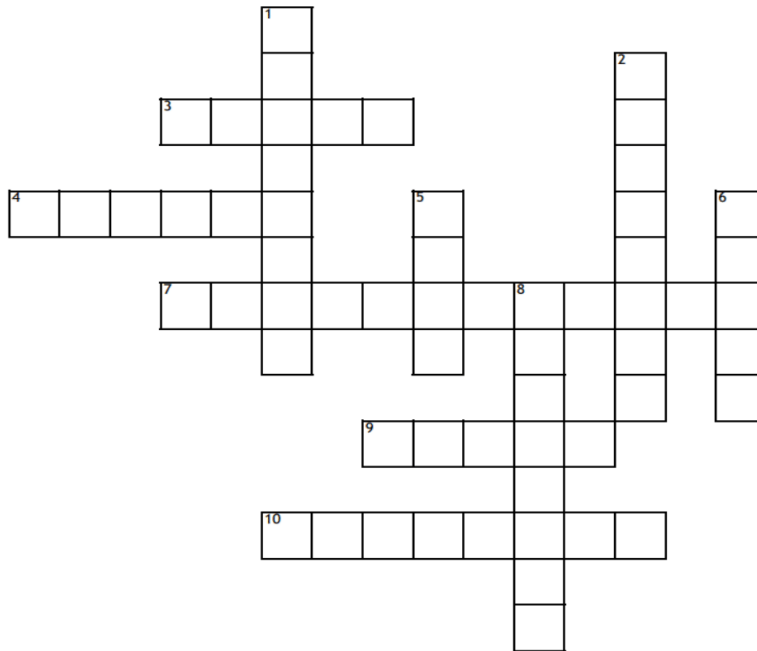
