


The CRC is wanting to host an information session facilitated by Jobs & Skills Centre Wheatbelt offering free information about their services and the options for career, training and employment services.



COMMUNITY CHILD CARE FUND – ESTABLISHING CHILD CARE IN LIMITED SUPPLY AREAS

4 May 2023

Federal Member for Durack, the Hon Melissa Price MP, encourages Child Care Subsidy approved providers across the Durack electorate to apply for funding as part of the Community Child Care Fund – Establishing Child Care in Limited Supply Areas. This is a federal funding round facilitated by the Department Education.

"I am strongly of the opinion that we need to encourage and promote regional living, which obviously requires having childcare options available for local residents. I believe this funding round will help our regional towns to flourish, socially and economically. Families will enjoy increased childcare options, allowing them to participate in the work, social and physical activities they may have been unable to do because of the lack of childcare in their area" Melissa Price said.

The intended outcomes of the grant opportunity are to:

- establish new early childhood services in communities experiencing disadvantage in regional or remote areas, where there is a gap in the supply of approved services.
- support newly established services in communities experiencing disadvantage in regional and remote areas, to operate sustainably, engage local workforce, and address community level barriers to participation in early childhood education.
- increase the number of children from communities experiencing disadvantage in regional and remote areas accessing early childhood education.
- increase the availability of approved ECEC in communities experiencing disadvantage in regional and remote areas, with high unmet demand through capital works projects.

"By investing in child care centres in regional areas, communities can support families, promote child development, and create a brighter future for their children and the broader community." Ms Price said.

Applications for this funding round close Thursday 1 June 2023.

SMALL COMMUNITY GRANTS NOW OPEN

The latest round of *Mia's Local Hero Grants*, a small grants program to help support local community groups across the Central Wheatbelt electorate is now open for applications.

Ms Davies said that in her role as the local State Member of Parliament she was pleased to support groups with the program offering small but meaningful grants to community and not-for-profit groups in the electorate.

"My latest Mia's Local Hero Grants program will provide amounts of up to \$200 for local groups who support and enrich the community they serve", Ms Davies said.

"This grant round is now open, and I'd encourage all eligible groups to make an application."

"The funds could be used to support or sponsor a local event, contribute toward the purchase of new equipment or materials, or to assist your group to better support your members or community."

Ms Davies said the grants provided an opportunity to show her support, thanks and appreciation for the hardworking volunteer and not-for-profit organisations that make such a difference in our community.

"The application process isn't onerous, but it is competitive so make sure you explain clearly how the money will be used and why it will benefit the community or people you support," she said.

"I'm looking forward to receiving the applications, and if anyone has concerns about their eligibility, they should contact my office."

This will be the 7th round of Mia's Local Hero Grants.

"I'm pleased to have delivered over \$45,000 in grant funding for 220 separate grants – going to groups in every Shire of the electorate of Central Wheatbelt," Ms Davies said.

Round 7 opens Monday 24th April 2023 and closes at 4.00pm on Friday 26th May 2023.

Pioneers of Pilgarn

Stage 1.

Citizens who built this district between years 1887 and 1914

Edwards, Alfred: Connected to the government water supply in the early years. When the pipeline reached Southern Cross in 1902 he was appointed Inspector.

Edwards was a valuable citizen, receiving a Commendation for establishing the Senior Cadet Corp in Southern Cross. His Corp later became the nucleus for enrolments to the First World War.

Edwards' miners right dated 1889 indicates he was indeed an early arrival. He recorded his recollections of the early days and these are now invaluable for historians.
