














#### Government services—closer than you think!

## Pioneers of Pilgarn

Stage 1.
Citizens who built this district between years 1887
and 1914

Egan, Tom: Came to Yilgarn in the 1890's cutting wood for the mines. In 1901 he built the Karalee hotel where he remained for some years. In his spare time he prospected for gold and cut wood for No 7 pump. He leased out the pub but remained in the area. In 1934 he was fortunate in being tipped off about a gold find nearby, the lease that Egan pegged becoming the main lease at Mount Palmer. subsequently sold out. Over the years Tom had tried his hand at wood cutting, prospecting, distilling oil from eucalyptus leaves, and running goats. In his twilight he moved to Kalgoorlie and died aged 96. This loveable larrikin can be termed a true pioneer of Yilgarn and the Karalee area in particular.
