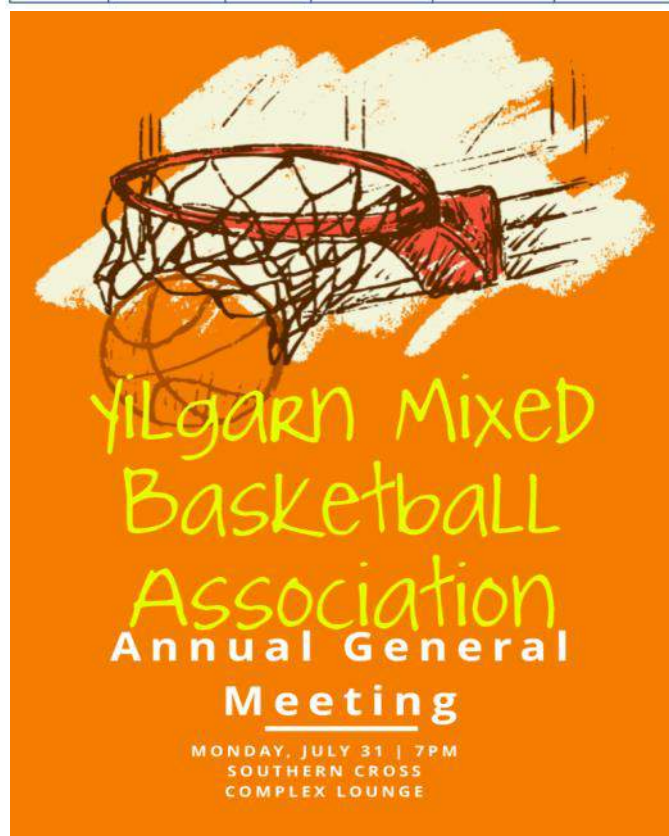

# Pioneers of Yilgarn

Stage 1.

Citizens who built this district between years 1887 and 1914

**Ford, William:** Ford worked on Southern Cross mines for some years. In company with Jacoletti, Ford's first claim to fame was finding the Jacoletti mine near Marvel Loch in 1890.

His main claim to fame was partnering Arthur Bayley in discovering Coolgardie in 1892.

This discovery altered the history of WA, and Southern Cross in particular. It started the great rush which trebled the State's population and led to a school and hospital and railway plus other improvements at Southern Cross.

It was the start of the golden years; not because of its gold, but its position as the jumping off point to the richer finds further east.
