Pioneers of Yilgarn

Stage 1.

Citizens who built this district between years 1887 and 1914

Gillett, Fred: Gillett was the first Anglican minister in Southern Cross, arriving June 1890. With the help of parishioners he built a church in Spica Street which was prefabricated in York.

A lean-to for accommodation was built on the side. In later years a house for the minister was built in Sirius Street, the railway dam nearby nick-named Parsons Dam.

Gillett was a livewire who walked from mining camp to mining camp, spreading the faith. Occasionally he borrowed a horse to reach outlying settlements.

Gillett was transferred after a few years but died at an early age leaving a young family. When the present Anglican Church was built on top of Memorial hill, the church erected by Gillett was moved to Marvel Loch for use by all denominations.

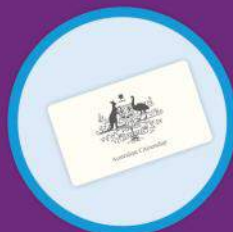

Stop Puppy Farming consultation open



Department of
Local Government, Sport
and Cultural Industries

The draft regulations are the next stage in achieving the objectives of the **Dog Amendment (Stop Puppy Farming) Act 2021** which also includes implementing a centralised registration system for cats and dogs (CRS).



The CRS will bring all local government pet registration data together for the first time and provide a more convenient, online system for pet owners and local governments.

Feedback is invited on the CRS' implementation and topics including:

- the sterilisation of dogs
- pet shops
- the supply of dogs by refuges or dog management facilities to approved pet shops
- approval to breed
- microchipping
- dog and cat registrations.

Responses will help inform the development of new regulations; specifications and functionality in the CRS; and resources needed by local government to implement and enforce legislative requirements.

A consultation paper has been developed to guide feedback on each topic.

The consultation period closes on 17 November 2023.

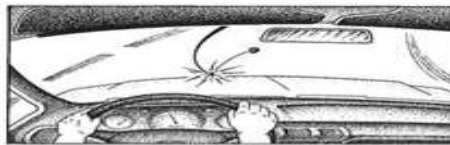
