# How to check in on someone

Helping others and providing support can make a difference for someone who is having problems and going through a tough time. If you think someone you care about isn't going so well, try the following tips on how to support them and continue to check in on them.



## Talk

For most people, just asking if they are okay and listening can make a difference.

By simply being there for someone, they can feel less alone and more supported to open up and talk about how they are really feeling.

Asking open ended questions that require a response is a good way to start the conversation.

### FOR EXAMPLE:

- How are you going? What's been happening in your life lately?
- You don't seem quite yourself lately, is something bothering you?
- You seem upset or worried, what's going on? Can I help with something?
- I've noticed you're not going out much lately, anything going on?



## Listen

Just being there for someone and offering a listening ear can make a difference.

1. Show them that you care and are here to listen to them.
2. Have patience, let others talk and don't judge.
3. Be reflective by repeating what they have said.
4. Keep calm and accept that they may disagree with you.



## Provide support

If the person you're concerned about is in a life threatening situation, or is at risk of harm to themselves or others, call 000.

Getting help early can make a difference. A good place to start is:

- Talk to your GP or someone you trust.
- Call a support line.
- Contact a support service.
- Try the Think Mental Health check-up tool.

They may also need your support while they look for professional help.



## Do an activity together

Activities create conversation. Find an opportunity during everyday life activities to start the conversation and ask them how they are really feeling. Try doing activities together such as:

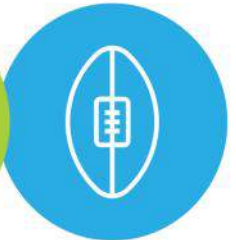

## Pioneers of Yilgarn

Stage 1.

Citizens who built this district between years 1887 and 1914

**Hampson, William:** 'Sailor Bill' had the distinction of building the first pub in Southern Cross during 1888. It was called Southern Cross Hotel, and situated on a mining lease near Frasers Mine. The hotel also incorporated a store which his wife ran while Hampson managed Hopes Hill mine. He advertised himself as gentleman and mining expert. Hampson would bring rich gold samples home each night and employ four men to turn the handles on a portable crushing machine, paying them with beer from his pub. The post office was set up in one corner of the store, Mrs Green moving the license from Golden Valley to Southern Cross in 1889 when that centre declined. Hampson was one of the original councillors elected to the Municipality in 1892 and lived up to his Gentleman and Mining Expert advertising. He was an asset to the Municipality and first auditor. Unfortunately Hampson's pub and store were outside the town boundary when it was surveyed in 1890, leading to it being abandoned and another hotel of the same name being built where the medical centre is today.

This is a life-changing experience for the students, with many having no previous exposure to rural life or the Wheatbelt.

By providing these rural immersion opportunities early in their degree, it has been proven that students are more likely to explore rural career opportunities.

Some students, who have previously been hosted through this program, continue to keep in touch and visit their host families, some return to do seasonal work and placements, others have joined mentoring programs, some have inspired host family members to pursue tertiary studies in health and medicine, and some students are now doctors in the Wheatbelt and other parts of rural/remote WA and Australia.

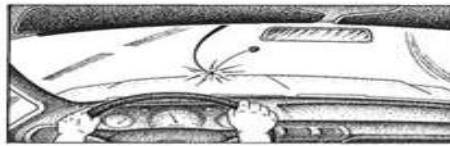
