ANZAC DAY Temporary Road Closure - Southern Cross


Residents are hereby advised that the following roads will be closed from **10.30am through to 12.00 noon on Thursday 25th April 2024** during the Anzac Day Service.





INFLUENZA VACCINES AVAILABLE AT SOUTHERN CROSS GENERAL PRACTICE FROM 16TH APRIL 2024

Influenza season is coming.

Influenza is a common viral infection that affects people of all ages. While it may be a mild disease for some, it can also cause serious illness and even lead to hospitalisation in otherwise healthy people. Vaccination, administered annually by a health professional is the safest means of protection from influenza. The strains of the virus circulating can change yearly, prompting updates to the vaccines based on expert advice. That's why it is important to get vaccinated every year. Timing is important – get the influenza vaccine in the cooler months (from April/May) and prior to the winter influenza peak (normally in June–August).

WA Health will be offering FREE flu vaccinations for all people aged over 5 during the months of MAY and JUNE

The NIP offers free Influenza vaccines to the below groups all year round:

- children aged 6 months to less than 5 years
- pregnant women at any stage of pregnancy
- First Nations people aged 6 months and over
- people aged 65 years and over
- people aged 6 months and over with certain medical conditions that increase their risk of severe influenza and its complications.

Styles' locket by Lance Stevens



The pictures shown here of the Styles Locket paints a tantalising mystery. Who owned it and wore it for all these years. What tales could it tell? The locket was recently discovered on the Kalbarri rubbish tip, and found its way back to Southern Cross museum by Good Samaritan finders, Andy and Janette Sharman.

The locket is made of sterling silver and engraved on one side 'C S Styles 53rd battery AIF 16112', and the other side engraved 'L E Styles AWAS 45864.' Two photos are inside which we presume are Cecil Styles and his daughter Lesley who were Southern Cross residents for many years.

Older residents will remember Cecil Styles and his wife May who ran a drapery business where the chemist shop is today. The family connection goes back to 1897 when Cecil's parents came to Southern Cross to establish the business. Cecil went to school here and finished his education at Guildford Grammar.

At the outbreak of WW1, Cecil joined the Royal Artillery, serving on the Somme and various parts of France. He returned to the drapery trade after the war, keeping an eye on branches at Westonia and Merredin that his father had started.

In 1922 Cecil married Mabel and had two daughters, Vuna and Lesley. His parents then retired after 27 years and returned to NSW, leaving Cecil and May with the business. The Styles family became noted for their hospitality and congenial manners.

During the second war, Cecil again enlisted and was stationed as a guard at Ghooli pumping station, before being posted to RAAF stores section in Merredin. May kept the home fires burning and looked after the drapery business.

Lesley joined the Australian Woman's Army when old enough. Vuna married Doug Watson in 1942, a former bank Johnie and now in the RAAF, the pair returning to Southern Cross in 1949 for two years when Doug was appointed manager of the same bank.

Meanwhile Cecil and May continued operating the drapery business until 1962, before selling to Olwen and Ken Beaton who promptly built a new shop.

The Styles' retired to City Beach to be closer to their daughters. They had seen Southern Cross droop several times over the years but revive again. Both died in 1967, Mabel the first to go and Cecil a day later.

Lesley never married. She became a gifted author and artist. In 1955 she and two friends embarked on a working trip around Australia which lasted several years. Unheard of in those days. She wrote about their travels, couched in good humour which became a best seller. Other books followed.

But Lesley's real passion was painting. For many years she lived at Wittenoom to capture the spectacular scenery and sunsets. Her work was often exhibited in Perth.

But we have not yet answered the riddle of the Locket, which is now on display in the museum. If you can help with this mystery the local historical society would love to hear from you.







What is proposed to be banned and when?

The sale and supply of disposable plastic and plastic-lined hot beverage cups (including coffee cups), with or without lids, that cannot be composted will be phased out from 27 February 2023.

There will be a transition period of 12 months before the rules are enforced to allow businesses to use up supplies and source alternative products.

Enforcement of the ban on takeaway coffee cups will commence on 1 March 2024.



Why ban takeaway coffee cups?

Each year, Western Australians use more than 154 million takeaway coffee cups.

Most takeaway coffee cups end up in landfill, but many are also littered. There are no widespread recycling options, and the cups contaminate kerbside recycling streams.

What is not included in the ban?

 compostable paperboard cups certified to Australian Standards for industrial (AS 4736:2006) or home (AS 5810:2010) composting



- · durable plastic cups designed for reuse
- plastic cups that are part of a pre-packaged product.

What alternatives are there?

Western Australians used 15 per cent fewer single-use plastic coffee cups in 2021–22 than in the previous year. Customers are encouraged to dine in, bring their own reusable cup or use cup exchange schemes. Businesses may provide disposable alternatives, such as certified compostable cups and lids, which are not banned and are widely available.







Will it cost more to buy a takeaway coffee?

Many cafes have already made the switch to compostable coffee cups.

Some compliant alternatives may initially cost businesses about 3 cents more per coffee. The cost will decrease over time as more options become available. The price of disposable plastic items does not reflect the costs to the community of plastic waste and pollution.

Who will the ban apply to?

The ban applies to all businesses, manufacturers, retailers, wholesalers and distributors that sell or supply takeaway hot beverage (coffee) cups.





What is proposed to be banned and when?

The sale and supply of disposable plastic trays not included in the Stage 1 ban will be phased out from 27 February 2023.

The ban includes packs of disposable trays sold by retailers as well as individual trays sold or supplied by hospitality businesses and other organisations. Examples include disposable sushi trays and bento boxes.

There will be a transition period of 12 months before the rules are enforced to allow businesses to use up supplies and source alternative products.

Enforcement of the ban on trays for food will commence on 1 March 2024.



Why ban plastic trays?

Disposable plastic trays are used in large quantities and are often littered. They usually contain food remnants which contaminates recycling streams.

What is not included in the ban?

- Plastic trays that form part of a pre-packaged product
- Compostable lined paperboard trays certified to Australian Standards for industrial (AS 4736:2006) or home (AS 5810:2010) composting
- · Plastic trays designed for reuse
- Plastic trays for raw meat and seafood (e.g. from butchers and supermarket meat sections) – also see the fact sheet for EPS raw meat and seafood trays



What alternatives are there?

There are several compliant non-plastic or lined disposable tray alternatives. These are made from bagasse fibre and paperboard with both suitable for takeaway food.

Will it cost more to buy takeaway food?

Compliant alternatives for plastic trays may initially cost businesses slightly more but this is expected to decrease as more options become available.

Who will the ban apply to?

The ban applies to all businesses, manufacturers, retailers and distributors that sell or supply disposable plastic food trays.

Pioneers of Pilgarn

Citizens who built this district between years 1887 and 1914

Lowe, Lawrie: Sister Laurie (Lowe) was the first of the Sisters of the People to help with typhoid victims at Southern Cross, arriving November 1894 to nurse patients in their own homes. The typhoid epidemic in WA lasted several years with the goldfields being the worst effected due poor hygiene. More nurses came later when Sister Lawrie was overwhelmed with patients seeking help and a tent hospital was erected alongside the government tent hospital. Sister Lawrie, herself, caught typhoid but fortunately recovered. As the typhoid epidemic eased at Southern Cross the sisters moved deeper into the goldfields to help others. Sister Lawrie left in December 1895 after thirteen months of dedicated nursing, asking for nothing in return. Whatever happened to this remarkable woman is unknown.


