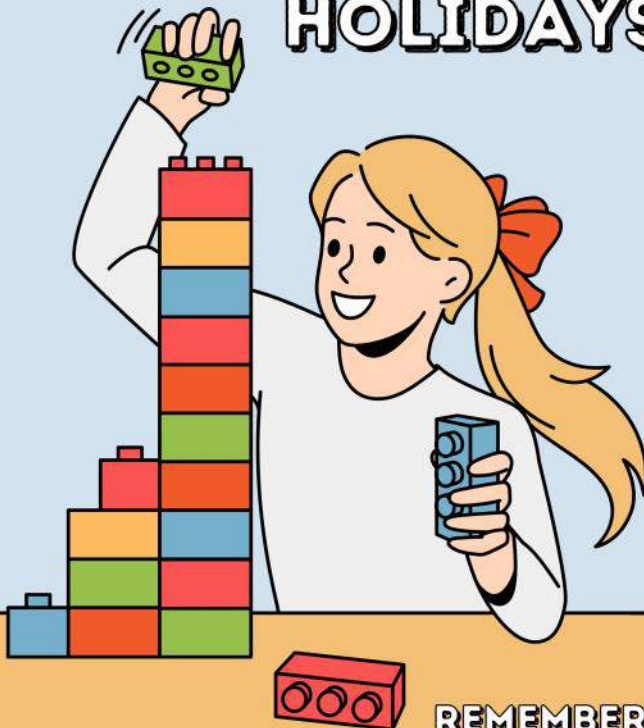

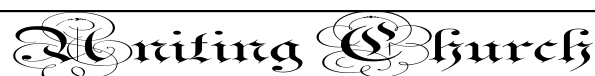

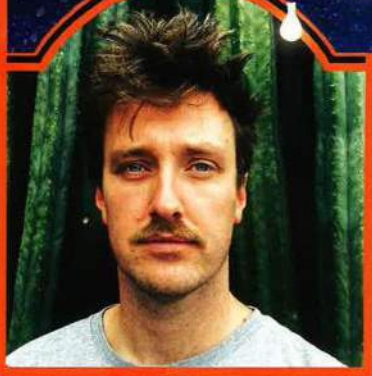

# Festival of Small Halls

Festival of Small Halls Australia is a series of tours that takes the best folk, traditional and contemporary acoustic artists and sends them on the road to tiny halls in communities all over Australia.

As of early 2023, we have produced 32 tours in collaboration with 172 local councils and 210 community groups and lifted the spirits of thousands of rural, regional and remote audience members.

It is produced by Woodfordia Inc in partnership with many other wonderful Australian festivals, regional partners and supporters of folk, traditional and contemporary acoustic music.

It's an opportunity for welcoming communities to invite fantastic international and domestic musicians into their towns, and a way of exploring this vast country in the spirit of hospitality, good music and great fun.

The artist line-up for Small Halls is usually one Australian artist and one International touring artist, who play music of exceptional quality and heart, travelling from town to town. They've been chosen for the tour not only because of their beautiful songs and tunes, but because they have the ability to really connect with the people they play for, whether through storytelling, the ability to tell a good joke (or a truly terrible one), and a real interest in visiting places a little off the beaten track.

The artists this year are: Alana Wilkinson from Australia and Jed Parsons from New Zealand.

# Mt Holland Road Upgrade

Covalent Lithium is excited to share that, in partnership with the Western Australian Government and Decmil Group, we are making substantial progress on the Mt Holland Road Upgrade project. This initiative is set to enhance the Parker Range and Marvel Loch Forrestania (MLF) Roads — vital arteries that connect the Great Eastern Highway to our Mt Holland Mine and Concentrator.

Our commitment to dependable infrastructure and community safety is at the heart of this project. The road upgrades will improve the transport of materials from Mt Holland to our Kwinana Refinery, benefitting all who travel these roads.

## Progress Snapshot:

- Works commenced in September 2023 and as of April's close, we've sealed 30km of our 113km upgrade path.
- Sealing operations are on hold due to the cold weather, but progress hasn't slowed:
  - Preparatory work is advancing on Parker Range Road's initial 30km.
  - Upgrade works continue on Parker Range Road, east of the Emu Fence Road intersection.
  - Upgrade works are underway south of Dunbar Road on MLF.

The project is well underway with an anticipated completion in March/April 2025.

# Pioneers of Yilgarn

Stage 1.

Citizens who built this district between years  
1887 and 1914

**Maiklem, Jim:** Came to Southern Cross in 1910 to work for the Municipality, afterwards working for the Government Water Supply at Southern Cross where he rose to become inspector and officer-in-charge. He was active in the local fire brigade and Freemasons Lodge. Jim married Minnie Carlson and joined two pioneer families, their children going on to become solid citizens. Jim died in 1956 and is buried in our local cemetery.

**Martin, William:** An important water contractor employed by Council to watch over New Zealand Gully town water supply, and be accountable for usage. He carted water to Southern Cross by spring cart and hawked it around town. He also kept several tanks in the main street full for firefighting. When the goldfields pipe arrived in 1902 he was contracted to watch over the standpipe and be accountable for usage and collection of charges, prior to the town being reticulated a year later.
