- Species must be planted to tackle poor production areas (issues such as salinity, wind erosion, or other 'land degradation matters').
- Seedlings will be delivered on-farm during June/July 2018. Applicants **must** be able to accept, care for (water every day) and plant seedlings at any time within this period.
- Stock **must** be kept off seedlings for the first 12 months.

Seedlings consist of 100% *Atriplex nummularia* – Old Man Saltbush.

Seedlings should be planted in blocks or belts at 1000 stems/ha depending on soil capacity and layout. There should be barley grass present as indicator that the species will survive on intended site.

Pioneers of Yilgarn

Stage 1.

**Citizens who built this district between years
1887 and 1914**

Hatt, David: Came to Southern Cross during late 1890's to become a big player in the mining scene. A plumber by trade, he designed steel vats to treat old battery sands by cyanide. Cyanide released the left-over gold which could not be extracted by ordinary means.

Hatt also owned Hatt's Reward gold mine on the edge of town. This operated by electricity, a new invention to Southern Cross. Hatt's battery was on top of Wimmera Hill where remains can still be seen today. When denied the use of free salt water from the lake to run his battery, Hatt moved lock stock and barrel to Never-Never (Nevoria) which had recently been discovered.

A township developed with Hatt being unofficial Mayor and largest employer. His energy and vision was a boon for the south region. Hatt committed suicide in 1910 when he got into financial trouble, a sad ending for an entrepreneur of Yilgarn.

My favourite thing about work experience was going in the dump truck. – Shandy

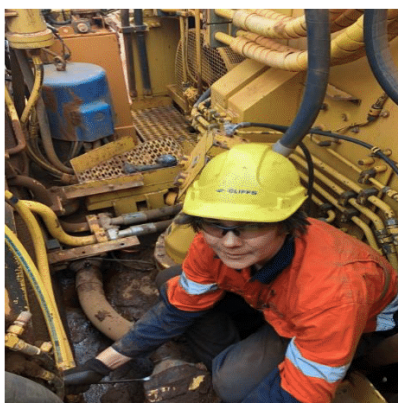


My favourite part about my work experience was working with the haulage workshop and being able to work on heavy and light machinery. – Dale

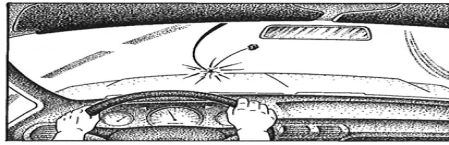
