## Pioneers of Yilgarn

Stage 1.

**Citizens who built this district between years  
1887 and 1914**

**Lowe, Lawrie:** Sister Laurie (Lowe) was the first  
of the Sisters of the People to help with typhoid  
victims at Southern Cross, arriving November  
1894 to nurse patients in their own homes. The  
typhoid epidemic in WA lasted several years with  
the goldfields being the worst effected due poor  
hygiene.

More nurses came later when Sister Lawrie was  
overwhelmed with patients seeking help and a  
tent hospital was erected alongside the  
government tent hospital. Sister Lawrie, herself,  
caught typhoid but fortunately recovered.

As the typhoid epidemic eased at Southern Cross  
the sisters moved deeper into the goldfields to  
help others. Sister Lawrie left in December 1895  
after thirteen months of dedicated nursing,  
asking for nothing in return.

Whatever happened to this remarkable woman is  
unknown.

## Welcome to our Flu Vaccination Program for 2018

We are pleased to advise that we have now received our Government funded influenza vaccines. If you would like to be vaccinated, please phone to make an appointment at the practice on 9049 1147 or email us [reception@sxgp.com.au](mailto:reception@sxgp.com.au)

### **Who is eligible for free flu vaccinations?**

Under the Australian Government's Immunisation Program the following groups can receive a free flu vaccine:

- pregnant women
- children aged 6 months to less than 5 years
- people 65 years and older
- Aboriginal individuals 6 months and older
- people 6 months and older with medical conditions that put them at risk of severe flu, including:
  - heart disease
  - kidney disease
  - chronic respiratory conditions
  - chronic illnesses that required regular medical attention or hospitalisation in the previous year
  - chronic neurological conditions
  - impaired immunity
  - children aged 6 months to 10 years receiving long-term aspirin therapy.

### **Private influenza vaccinations:**

We are offering private flu vaccines for a small cost to those who do not meet the above criteria, and also for those companies who wish to have their employees vaccinated. Please contact the practice on 9049 1147 for appointment scheduling.

### **Help to stop flu from spreading**

For best protection against flu, people are advised to get the flu vaccine in late autumn. This will help ensure they are protected throughout peak flu season, which in Western Australia is usually August. This follows recent evidence that shows flu immunisation may wane after 3 to 4 months (Department of Health WA, 2018)

Good hygiene practices, such as washing your hands thoroughly with soap and warm water can assist with reducing the risk of infection.

### **Call for landholder views on wild rabbits and feral pigs**

The Department of Primary Industries and Regional Development (DPIRD) is calling on landholders affected by wild rabbits and feral pigs to complete an online survey to help manage these destructive pests.

Working in partnership with Recognised Biosecurity Groups (RBGs) and other community groups, the department is seeking to better understand the impact wild rabbits and feral pigs are having on farms, the issues people encounter trying to control them, and where landholders may need assistance.

The responses to the survey will assist RBGs and community groups develop coordinated control programs and therefore have the best chance of success.

Department development officer James Dee said that despite the release of effective biological control methods, communities still have a pivotal role to play with traditional control programs.

“The release of the RHDV1-K5 virus last year has been effective in reducing wild rabbit numbers, and using traditional techniques now will capitalise on that reduction,” he said.

“It’s estimated that the virus has reduced the wild rabbit population by 42%, but for effective control we need to get that down significantly further.

“Feral pigs are on the increase and being found in new areas around the state, and unfortunately there is no effective biological control agent that can be used against them.

“To successfully manage wild rabbits and feral pigs, which are both prolific breeders and can have such a devastating impact on agriculture, coordinated control programs are essential.”

The survey only takes five minutes to complete. It asks respondents about the damage that the pests have caused to their property, what kind of monitoring activities they’ve conducted, and what control methods they have used.

“Once we’ve analysed the results, it will give the department, RBGs and other community groups a better understanding of the challenges associated with controlling wild rabbits and feral pigs,” Mr Dee said.

“We’ll then continue to work with landholders to develop and refine strategies that will help reduce numbers and protect their valuable agricultural assets.”

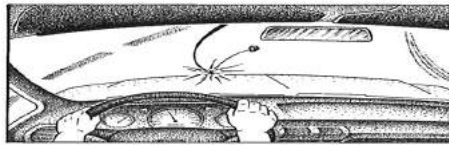
