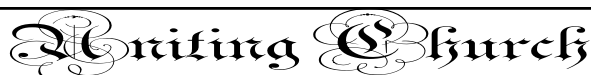

LANDFILL CHANGES

As advised in previous Crossword editions, a review of the opening times and general operations of the landfill facility was to be undertaken, with feedback from the community sought. This review has now been completed with Council endorsing the following opening times.

GENERAL INFORMATION

The review identified a number of incorrect assumptions in the community, which are addressed below:

- The fees do not apply to residential refuse, deposited by a Yilgarn resident within the designated operating hours;
- The fees and charges apply to all commercially generated waste. This includes waste generated from the cleaning/clearing of residential properties for reward;
- In comparison to other similar landfill facilities in the eastern Wheatbelt, the commercial rates are on the lower end of the scale and are set to assist in covering costs. These will be reviewed annually as part of the annual adoption of the fees and charges;
- The commercial fees do not apply to non-profit organisations and recyclable materials, sorted and placed in provided bulk bins or designated recycling areas;
- The fees are per cubic metre and are measured onsite by the attendant. Commercial customers are required to sign the acceptance form confirming they agree with the measured amount to be invoiced.
- Commercial refuse fees are not new, as has been inferred by some community members. There have always been commercial fees and charges, however with the transfer station being unstaffed, applying the fees was not able to be undertaken.
- Up until 2016/2017 refuse fees applied to both commercial and residential refuse, however this was changed to only commercial in the 2016/2017 budget and the rates for general commercial rubbish were reduced.

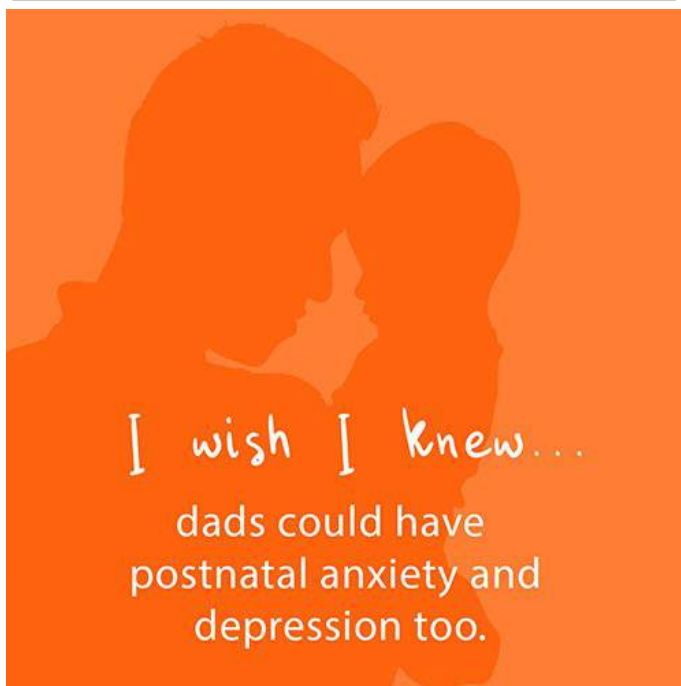

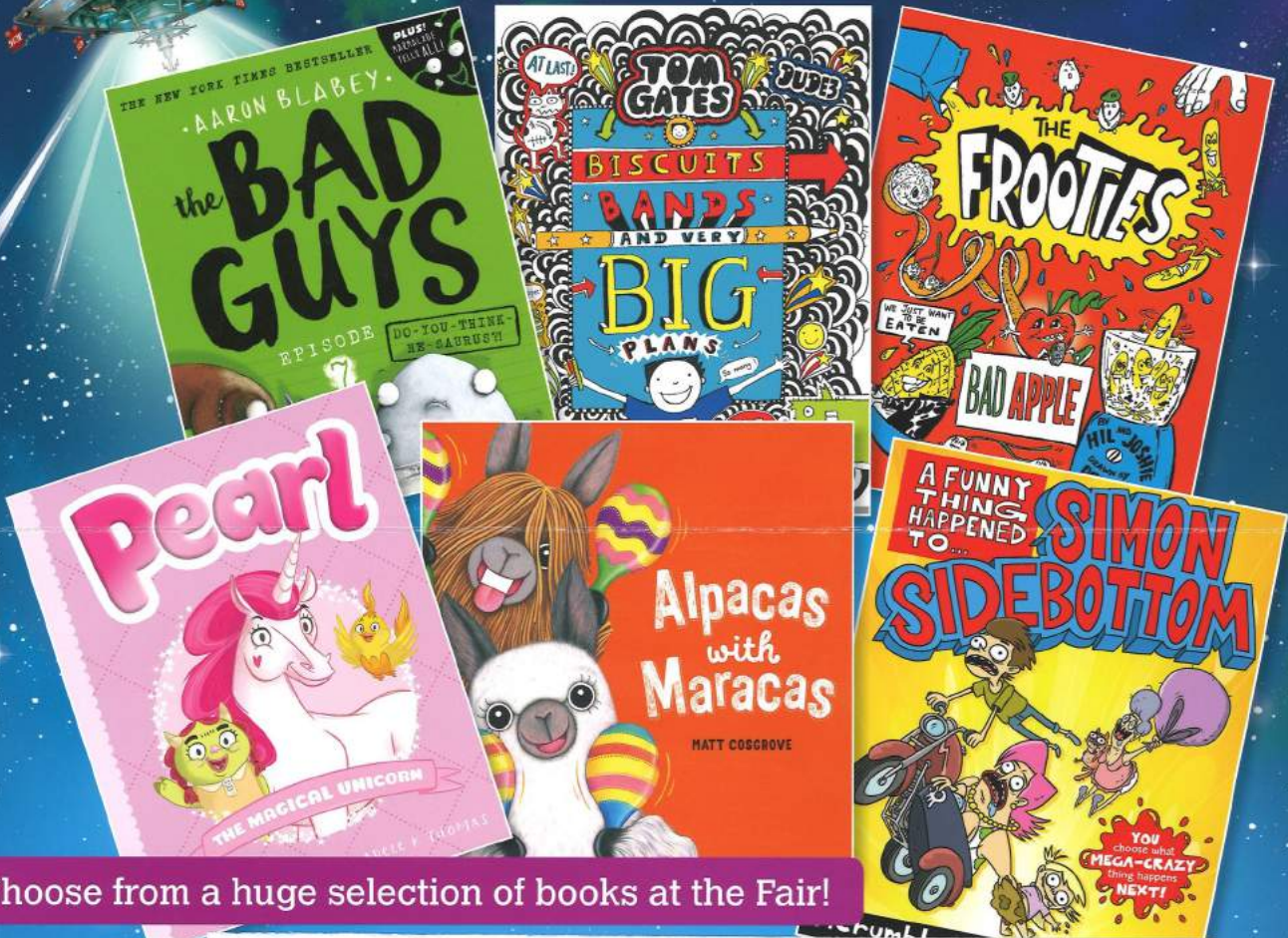

YILGARN HISTORY MUSEUM SOUTHERN CROSS INC.

Legend of the star constellation 'Southern Cross'

A long long time ago there was no Southern Cross in the sky. The stars were all clustered together in groups in the Milky Way, with wide open spaces between the groups. Sometimes one cluster of stars visited another and occasionally stars got lost and fell down to earth as we see them do, even today. Sometimes it took the stars a long time to return to their own country. Even now they can be seen travelling to and fro across the heavens if one watches closely.

However the Southern Cross is different from other stars, as it never travels. The five stars are all women.

Originally these women who make up the Southern Cross belonged to an aboriginal tribe. They had travelled a long distance following the wild animals, and arrived in this district at dusk. They found water and firewood to be some distance apart. After a tribal discussion it was decided to build their mia mia's nearer to the wood than the water.

After supper the grown-ups went down to the waterhole and had a drink. The smaller children were too tired to go to the waterhole, so several bigger girls were given big pieces of bark and told to fetch water for the youngsters.

But instead of coming straight back the girls stopped to play along the way. They splashed each other and wasted the water.

By this time it was dark and the men were anxious. They went looking and found the girls playing, and no water left. The men were angry.

They raised their hunting spears and prodded the girls in the calves of their legs. The girls tried to protect themselves by holding the bark over their legs, and running away. They ran as fast as they could but the men followed with their spears.

As they ran, a big willy-willy came up and suddenly blew the girls into the sky. The men threw their spears after them, but they scattered to avoid the spears, and that is why they are not clustered like the other stars.

Ever since that day they have remained in the sky to form the Southern Cross. They are afraid to come back for fear they will be speared for running away.

This is a lesson to other girls not to loiter and play when they have duties to perform. And being so far away they can never find a man, therefore they can never get married.

The Southern Cross, after which this town is named, can be found low down in the night sky in a southerly direction, more or less in line with Antares Street. This dream time story now explains how it was formed.

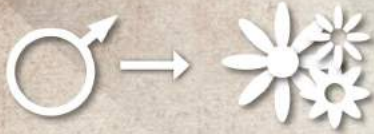

Read the fine print before you “put a ring on it”

With the average Australian wedding costing \$36,200, make sure your “I do’s” do not turn into bad memories by doing your homework on wedding suppliers before you engage them.

From 1 October 2017 to 30 September 2018 Consumer Protection received 79 formal complaints and 181 enquiries in relation to weddings.

We recently heard from a bride-to-be who purchased a gown from a reputable wedding store featuring French silk lace, but later found she received a dress with polyester lace. Other common complaints are with online purchases and custom designed clothing and jewellery not measuring up to claims and issues with lay-by agreements.

Many newly married couples are also frustrated by photographers and videographers who have failed to deliver already paid-for images of their special day.

Consumer Protection recently prosecuted a wedding photographer who was fined \$4,500 by the Perth Magistrates Court and ordered to pay \$5,650 in compensation to three consumers for failing to supply the promised photo and video packages or for delaying the supply. One couple who dealt with the business were still waiting for their wedding video almost three years later.

Before engaging any services, you should get recommendations from friends and family. In the case of photographers, verify claims by asking to see previous work and speaking to past clients.

Remember, a wedding is a significant life event so use a professional and insist on professional standards. Be careful when choosing someone who is operating as a paying hobby.

We also recommend that you do not pay the full amount up front for these types of services, as this reduces your bargaining power should there be a delay in delivery and also takes away an incentive for the trader to complete the job on time. Consumers should get a formal written quote which sets out exactly what is included in the price of services and sets reasonable timeframes for delivery.

When it comes to wedding attire, if possible, always ask for samples. Try on the style of dress or suit before you have it made and check the details of the lay-by arrangement carefully.

Consider paying by credit card so if something goes wrong with your purchase, or if goods are not delivered, there may be an option to request a chargeback to reverse the transaction.

To avoid disappointment when booking a venue, read the fine print of the contract so you are not out of pocket if you cancel or, even worse, you are aware of your rights should the venue cancel on you a few weeks before the wedding.

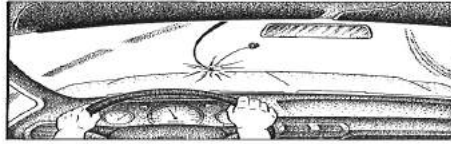
