

Yilgarn Local Action Group: Skeleton Weed

The Yilgarn Local Action Group would like to wish all its landholders well for this years harvest and festive period.

Plants are out and flowering so watch out!

There have been a few changes to the Skeleton Weed program for the 19/20 season as directed by the Department of Primary Industry & Regional Development:

- New Finds, Code 1 & Code 3 paddocks are eligible for search assistance (\$6/ha, up from last year.)
- <u>Code 2 paddocks:</u> If you find plants, it immediately becomes a Code 1 and eligible for search assistance after a FULL search is carried out.
- All code one paddocks needed to be <u>searched</u> by the **31st of December 2019.** All other codes need to be searched by the **31st of January 2020**.
- All property and **paddock records** to be sent in by the **15th February 2020**.
- Whilst invoices need to be sent in by March 15th, the sooner you complete

paperwork, the sooner you'll be paid.



Assessment Criteria:

Preference will be given to landholders who haven't received many/any Shire projects in the past.

- Species must be planted to tackle poor production areas (issues such as salinity, wind erosion, or other 'land degradation matters').
- Saltbush Seedlings will be delivered on-farm during late June/early July 2020. Applicants **must** be able to accept, water daily and plant seedlings at any time within this period.
- Stock **must** be kept off saltbush seedlings for the first 12 months.

Planting information:

Seedlings should be planted in blocks or belts at 1000 stems/ha depending on soil capacity and layout. There should be barley grass present as indicator that the species will survive on intended site.

Seedling Information:


The Shire of Yilgarn is proposing that a subsidy of 20 cents per seedling be paid by the receiving landholder to help offset the costs involved (each Oldman seedling costs 50 cents). Oldman Saltbush is native to the semi-arid areas of Australia and is well adapted to conditions.

Did You Know?

Did you know the first school in Southern Cross was run by the Wesleyan Church? It operated from 1891 to 1894 and was situated opposite the two-story cafe in the main street. The first State School opened in 1895, alongside the present medical centre. The rented building was made of hessian and canvas, but did the job for a year. The old stone State School, which still stands, opened in 1896. The builder started erecting it on the present football oval which had more room, but the people kicked up such a fuss that it was moved to its present position. This building was earmarked for demolition during the 1970's but was saved by the Historical Society led by Mrs Forrester. The first teacher, John McKie, died of a heart attack in 1898 and is buried in the local cemetery.

In Western Australia: One person dies every
