### **Assessment Criteria:**

Preference will be given to landholders who haven't received many/any Shire projects in the past.

- Species must be planted to tackle poor production areas (issues such as salinity, wind erosion, or other 'land degradation matters').
- Saltbush Seedlings will be delivered on-farm during late June/early July 2020. Applicants **must** be able to accept, water daily and plant seedlings at any time within this period.
- Stock must be kept off saltbush seedlings for the first 12 months.

### **Planting information:**

Seedlings should be planted in blocks or belts at 1000 stems/ha depending on soil capacity and layout. There should be barley grass present as indicator that the species will survive on intended site.

### **Seedling Information:**

The Shire of Yilgarn is proposing that a subsidy of 20 cents per seedling be paid by the receiving landholder to help offset the costs involved (each Oldman seedling costs 50 cents). Oldman Saltbush is native to the semi-arid areas of Australia and is well adapted to conditions.

# Yilgarn Local Action Group: Skeleton Weed

The Yilgarn Local Action Group would like to wish all its landholders well for this years harvest and festive period.

Plants are out and flowering so watch out!

There have been a few changes to the Skeleton Weed program for the 19/20 season as directed by the Department of Primary Industry & Regional Development:

- New Finds, Code 1 & Code 3 paddocks are eligible for search assistance (\$6/ha, up from last year.)
- Code 2 paddocks: If you find plants, it immediately becomes a Code 1 and eligible for search assistance after a FULL search is carried out.
- All code one paddocks needed to be <u>searched</u> by the <u>31st of December</u>
   2019. All other codes needed to be searched by the <u>31st of January 2020</u>.
- All property and paddock records to be sent in by the 15th February 2020.
- Whilst invoices need to be sent in by March 15th, the sooner you complete
   paperwork, the sooner you'll be paid.





## **AMBOS AND POLICE JOIN FORCES**

With numbers of volunteer Ambulance officers at an all time low, and with some officers going on leave, Sgt Dave Thirlwell jumped into action to help ensure that if there was an emergency situation requiring a Defibrillator, there would be one available for the police officers to use.

Dave and Deb approached St John Ambulance in Southern Cross, and they were only too eager to assist.

All Police Officers are fully trained in CPR and the use of Defibrillators, but are not supplied with the life saving devices.

St John Ambulance does not receive funding from Perth for this venture, but raise money from memberships, on call charges and first aid training.

Additional funds come by way of donations (notably from St Fire Ball steel roundup, and Yilgarn Agencies – who donated \$5,000.00 recently).

St John Ambulance have donated Defibrillators to the Shire, in order to allow the public access to these vital machines.

Defibrillators cost \$2,000.00, and St John Ambulance are glad to assist wherever they can.

# Did You Know?

**Did you know** the Catholic School opened in August 1898? The school doubled as a church. In 1900 the Presentation Sisters took over the teaching role. When the Bishop saw the trying conditions under which the Sisters worked and lived, he instigated the erection of the present school building which opened in August 1900.

Construction was done on the cheap and was a disaster. The builder had used ruberoid, a tough type of tar paper, for the walls and roof. Coupled with incorrect calculations, the tar paper peeled off and the framework broke away during a storm shortly afterwards.

For a period the sisters were teaching without a roof. The building required bracing with long wooden poles which were still there 50 years later. During 1904 a dispute with the Benedictine Order (which had recently taken over Southern Cross parish from Perth Diocese) led to the Presentation Sisters leaving.

The school remained closed for the year of 1905 and pupils went to the State School. In 1906 the Sisters of St Joseph reopened the Catholic school and began a long association with the town. In 1990 lay teachers took over the teaching role, the first principal being Gary Burges. The Catholic School has always been a credit to the town and still turns out first class scholars to this day.


