Preference will be given to landholders who haven't received many/any Shire projects in the past.

- Species must be planted to tackle poor production areas (issues such as salinity, wind erosion, or other 'land degradation matters').
- Saltbush Seedlings will be delivered on-farm during late June/early July 2020. Applicants **must** be able to accept, water daily and plant seedlings at any time within this period.
- Stock **must** be kept off saltbush seedlings for the first 12 months.

Planting information:

Seedlings should be planted in blocks or belts at 1000 stems/ha depending on soil capacity and layout. There should be barley grass present as indicator that the species will survive on intended site.

Seedling Information:

The Shire of Yilgarn is proposing that a subsidy of 20 cents per seedling be paid by the receiving landholder to help offset the costs involved (each Oldman seedling costs 50 cents). Oldman Saltbush is native to the semi-arid areas of Australia and is well adapted to conditions.





February is Ovarian Cancer Awareness Month



Cancer Council WA has welcomed new data revealing the incidence rate of ovarian cancer in WA women is the lowest it has been since the WA Department of Health began collecting data in 1982. The rate of new cases of ovarian cancer has been gradually trending down with 8.2 cases per 100,000 females in 2017 compared to 13.7 cases per 100,000 females in 1982.

However, Cancer Council WA's Wheatbelt Regional Education Officer, Melissa Pickering, said while this was good news, women needed to remain vigilant as ovarian cancer symptoms were vague and women often attribute them to other benign conditions. "Because it's difficult to detect in its early stages, there are more deaths from ovarian cancer in Australia than any other gynaecological cancer," she said.

In 2017, there were 115 reported new cases of ovarian cancer and 94 deaths due to an ovarian cancer diagnosis.

Ms Pickering said that women should pay attention to any symptoms that are unusual, new, persistent or troublesome. "If you have any of the symptoms and they happen on most days for three weeks or more, particularly if you're over 50 or have a strong family history of breast or ovarian cancer, go to your doctor and get a check-up," she said.

"You won't be wasting the doctor's time, and in most cases it won't be anything to worry about, but if it is cancer and you find it early, your chances of successfully treating it are much greater.

Symptoms can include:

- pain in the lower tummy (abdomen) or side
- a bloated, full feeling in the abdomen
- irregular periods or vaginal bleeding after menopause
- back pain
- passing urine more often than usual
- change in bowel habits or constipation
- pain during sex
- a swollen abdomen
- a feeling of fullness or loss of appetite
- indigestion or nausea

"More research is required to better understand the causes on ovarian cancer, but as with many cancers there are steps we can all do to reduce our overall individual cancer risk, including quitting smoking, maintaining a healthy body weight, getting enough exercise and fruit and vegetables, and reducing alcohol intake."

The chance of a woman developing ovarian cancer by the time she is aged 85 is 1 in 85. Ovarian cancer is most common in women over the age of 50.





Did You Know?

Did you know that Moorine Rock School opened on 8th June 1926? A railway cottage was utilised as a temporary school, the cottage providing accommodation for teacher Miss B Armstrong. Ten students were enrolled. The cottage served as a school for ten years. In 1937 the Rocky Gully school building was moved to Moorine and re-erected on the present school grounds; it is still in use today. By this stage school numbers had crept up to forty and two teachers were needed. But the depression followed by war impacted on student numbers. In 1942 the de-licensed Moorine hotel was turned into a temporary convent and school, billeting students from Highgate School until all threat of bombs on Perth had passed. Consolidation of schools reared its head during the war years due lack of teachers. It was considered that several schools in Yilgarn be closed and children bussed to Southern Cross. But Moorine parents were against closure. Despite several attempts at amalgamation since, Moorine school is still going strong.
